



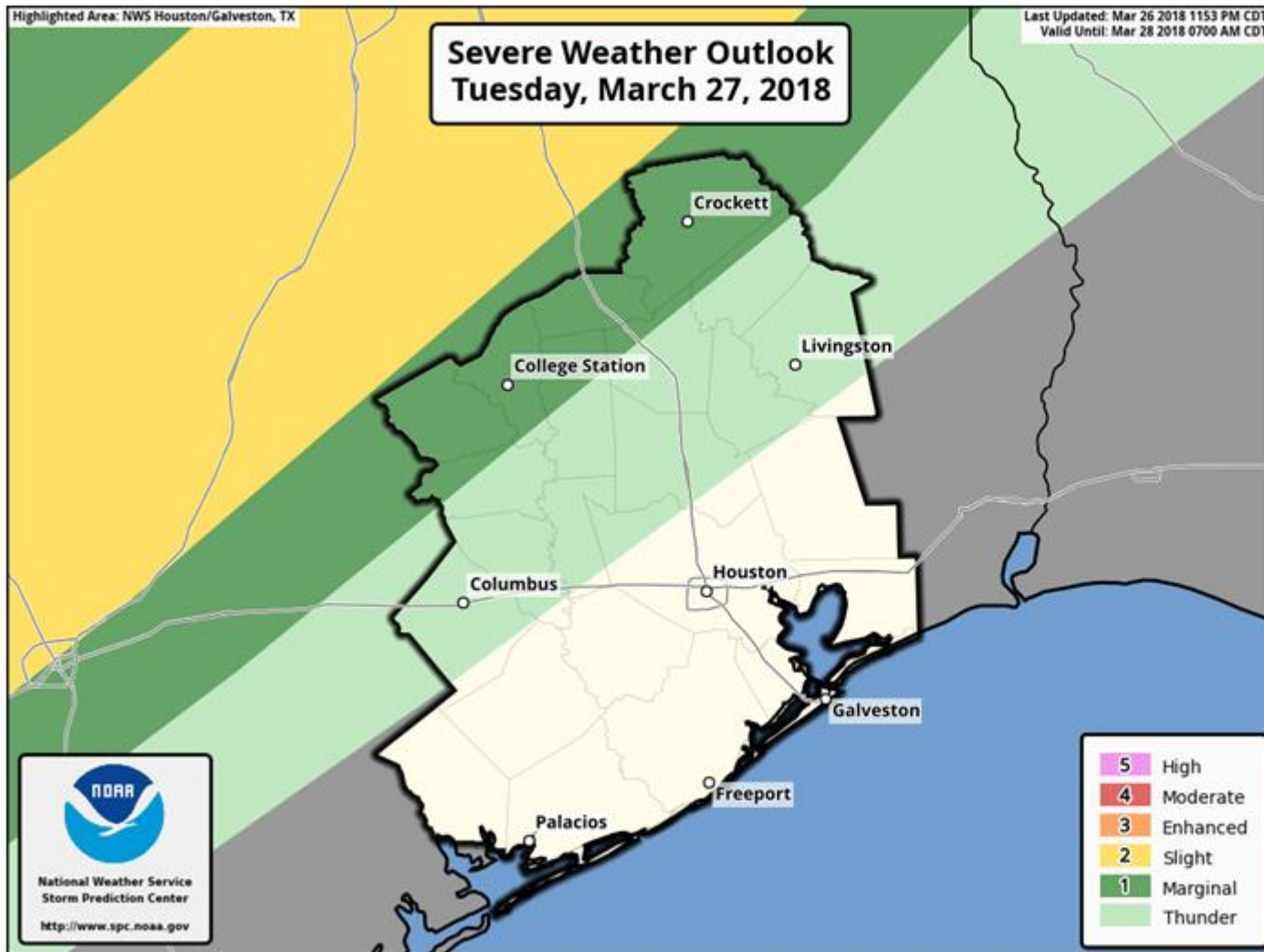

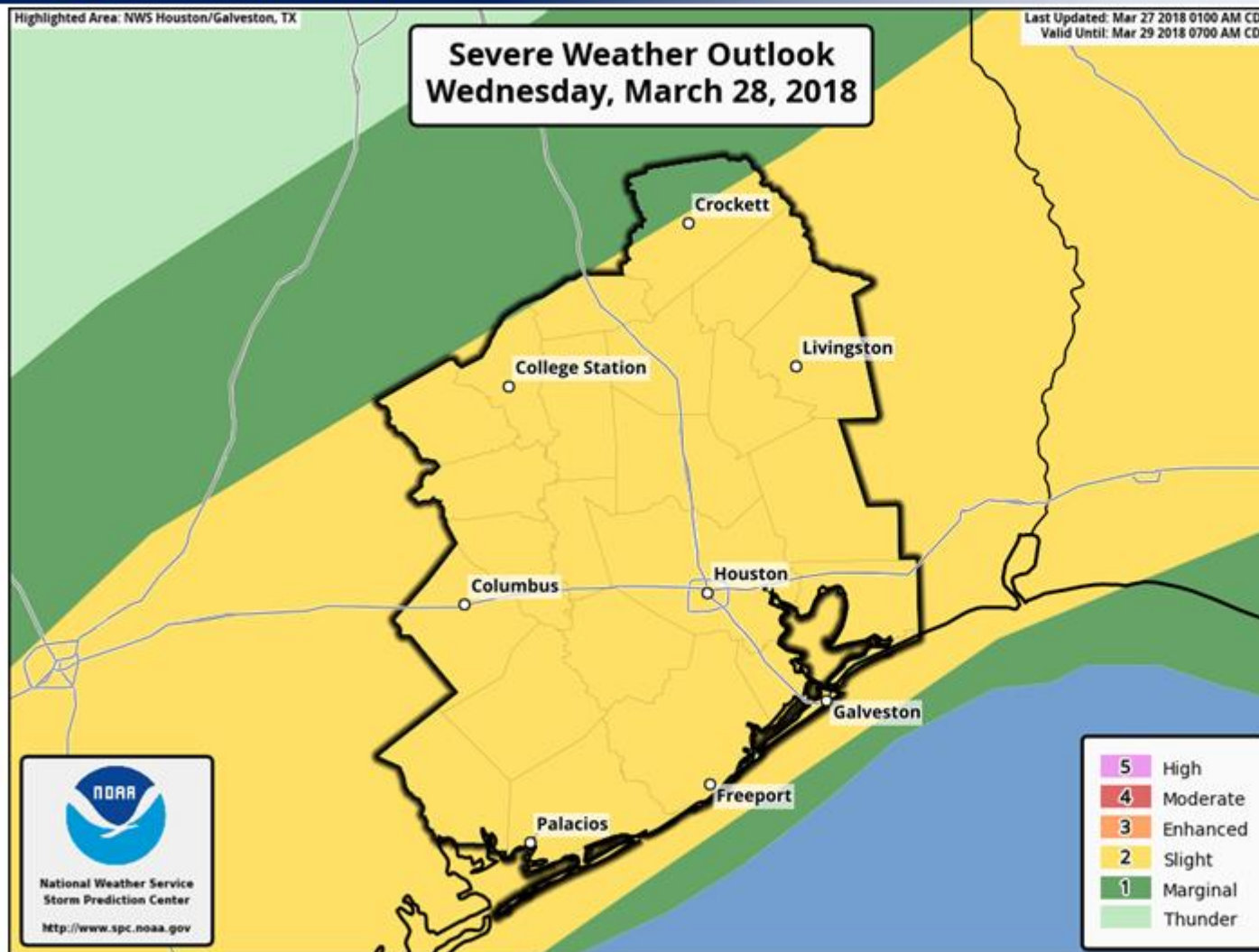

National Weather Service Houston/Galveston



**Yellow** areas (almost all of Southeast Texas) have a Slight Risk of severe thunderstorms

**Dark green** areas have a Marginal Risk of severe thunderstorms.

#### Threats:

Hail 1" in diameter,  
Damaging winds >60mph  
Isolated tornadoes

#### Timing:

Wednesday through early  
Thursday morning

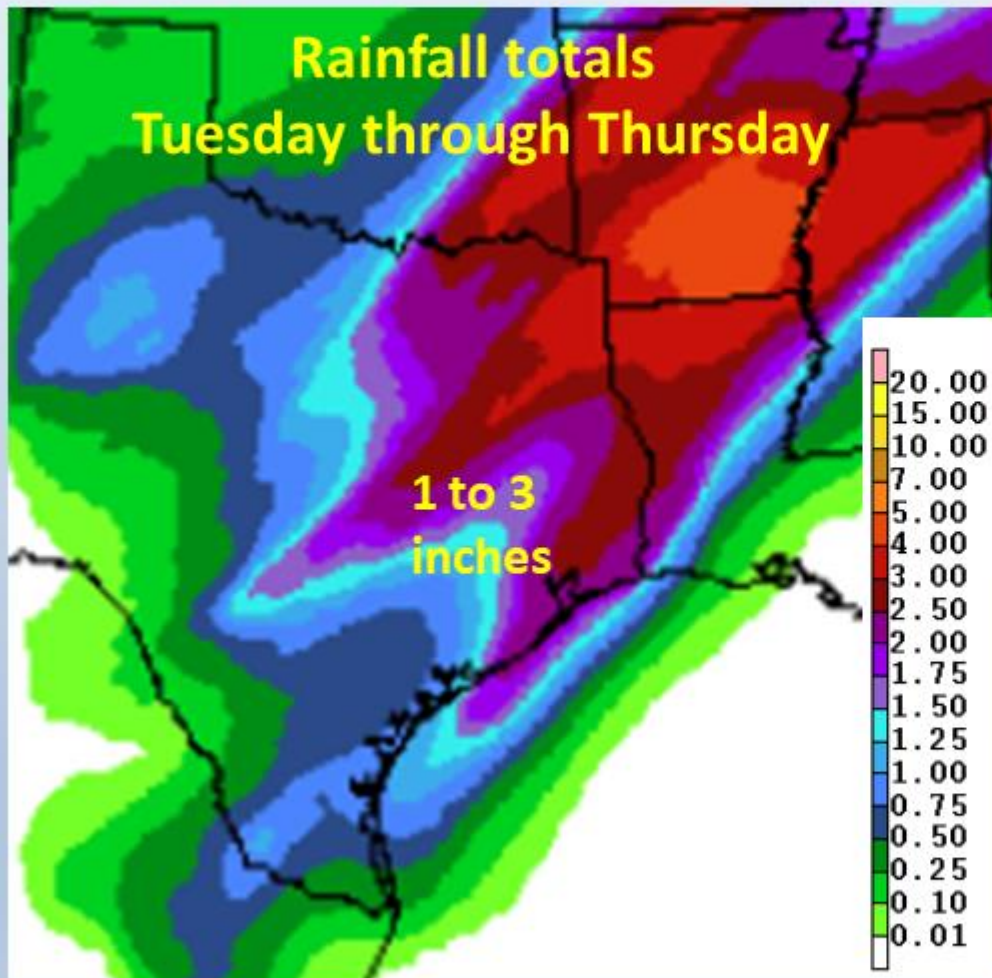

## Locally Heavy Rainfall

is possible across much of Southeast Texas in association with a slow moving storm system and associated cold front.

**Totals:** 1 to 3 inches with locally higher amounts.

**Timing:** mainly late tonight through Thursday morning.

**Keep up with the forecast for updates as changes to the timing and amounts are possible.**
