


Severe Weather Outlook - Day 1

National Weather Service Houston/Galveston



Dark green areas have a Marginal Risk of severe thunderstorms.

Threats:
Hail 1" in diameter
Damaging winds >60mph


Timing: Mainly tonight through early Wednesday morning

Severe Weather Outlook - Day 2

National Weather Service Houston/Galveston



Yellow areas (almost all of Southeast Texas) have a Slight Risk of severe thunderstorms

Dark green areas have a Marginal Risk of severe thunderstorms.

Threats:

Hail 1" in diameter,
Damaging winds >60mph
Isolated tornadoes

Timing:

Wednesday through early Thursday morning

Locally Heavy Rainfall

is possible across much of Southeast Texas in association with a slow moving storm system and associated cold front.

Totals: 1 to 3 inches with locally higher amounts.

Timing: mainly late tonight through Thursday morning.

Keep up with the forecast for updates as changes to the timing and amounts are possible.
