RE: Holiday Update

Today Gus, Arni, Shurland and I met to update progress on the December 17, 1992 Holiday event. We agreed to:

- o Contact restaurants identified as potential hosts of the event by telephone to gather information. Arni will call Cafe Majestic; Mike will call Iron Wood Cafe and Oppenheimers; Gus will call Cendrillon. Shurland already contacted Alcatraz and found Steve Fleming was still employed at Alcatraz and will continue working with him as needed. Phone inquiries are to be completed by the next meeting.
- o Review invitations from last year. It was mentioned having the invitation along with the menu, etc. in one package was worth repeating. Arni and Shurland will search for invitations in files.
- o There was concern about inviting 30 people (staff, non-paid staff, significant others) since it was perceived we already have approximately 30 people WITHOUT counting significant others. The committee tallied: 10 staff; 6 Board of Director members; 3 interns/ administrative non-paid staff and 10 active support group facilitators. If everyone were to invite a significant other, that would bring our total to approximately 60 people.
- o To deal with the above item, the committee decided it would need to obtain a hard copy of the employee's list/database in order to be sure we are not over our maximum count. It was suggested that program people submit the names of those to be invited against the criteria of people who have been actively involved with the agency during the past year. Then and only then would we be able to decide the significant other issue.

The holiday committee will meet every week to keep activities on track.
The next meeting is scheduled for Wednesday, October 14th at 3:00 p.m.

are presenting a weekend training, January 31, February 2, and 3, 1992
for volunteer facilitators for HIV positive support groups.**

Goal of the Training:

The main goal is to prepare volunteers to facilitate support groups (see description below) for HIV positive people.

Description and Goal of the Support Groups:

These groups will typically meet on a weekly basis, in group members homes or apartments. The main purpose of the groups is to provide a place for people with HIV to exchange information and to offer support to one another.

Format of the Weekend Training:

The training will address the following areas:

- Basic information about HIV/AIDS
- Emotional issues associated with being HIV positive
- Basic group facilitation skills
- Handling difficult situations that come up in group
- Crises intervention skills
- Community services and resources

Some of the training will involve presentations and exercises guided by the trainers. There will be a heavy emphasis on group participation, including discussion, role-plays, and sharing of experiences.

Participants are asked to be present for the entire weekend schedule. The schedule is:

- Friday, January 31, 7:00 p.m. to 9:30 p.m. (Check in is 6:30-7:00 p.m.)
- Saturday, February 1, 9:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. (Coffee/Tea Available 9:00-9:30 a.m.)
- Sunday, February 2, 9:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. (Coffee/Tea Available 9:00-9:30 a.m.)

Participants are not required to have previous experience as a counselor or group facilitator.
