DIRECTIONS TO ALTA BATES HOSPITAL:

From San Francisco, take the Oakland-SF Bay Bridge and follow route 80-17 (along the Eastshore Freeway towards Berkeley) to the Ashby exit.

From the north bay, Vallejo, Sacramento area, take Interstate Highway 80 south to Berkeley. Take the Ashby exit.

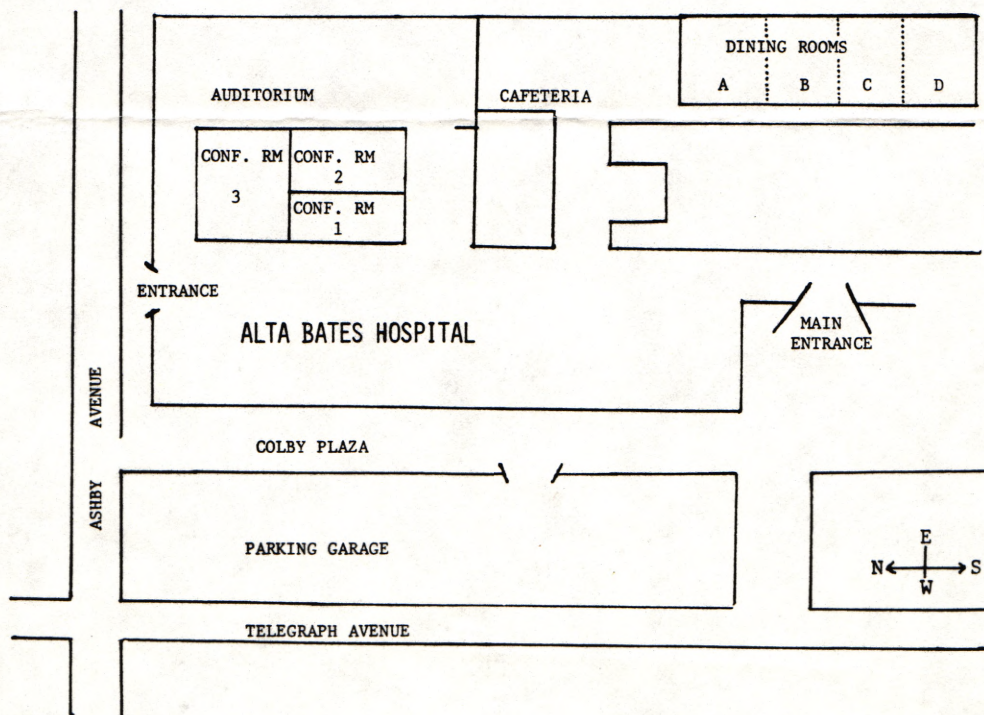
From the south bay, take Interstate Highway 80-17 north to Berkeley and take the Ashby exit.

After taking the exit, follow Ashby Avenue as it proceeds east through Berkeley. Drive east for about 2 to 2-1/2 miles until you reach TELEGRAPH AVENUE. Proceed east on Ashby, 1 block past Telegraph to COLBY PLAZA. The parking garage is located on the right of Colby Plaza. All-day parking is available for \$4.00. The hospital is across the street from the garage.

It is approximately 25-35 minutes from San Francisco to Alta Bates in mid-day traffic.

The Auditorium is located on the Ground Floor, closest to the Ashby Street entrance. As you come in the main entrance, turn left; the auditorium is down that corridor on the right.

Thank you so much for your invitation to speak at the Alta Bates Hospital on Tuesday, July 19. I am happy to accept.

At your request I have enclosed the audiovisual card, a curriculum vitae and will below delineate a brief introductory biography:

Dr. Wofsy is here today to talk about the much publicized acquired immunodeficiency syndrome, a subject with which she has had considerable clinical experience. Dr. Wofsy did internal medicine training at UC-San Diego, and after six years as associate director of mission emergency, returned to academics to do an infectious disease fellowship. She is now assistant chief of the Division of Infectious Diseases at San Francisco General Hospital and co-director of the AIDS Clinic at San Francisco General Hospital. She and her colleagues have been involved in the clinical care and research activities involving approximately 80 patients with documented AIDS in the San Francisco area.

In closing, I should advise you that I will be driving and I would indeed very much appreciate a complementary validation to park in the Alta Bates garage, if that is necessary at entry.
