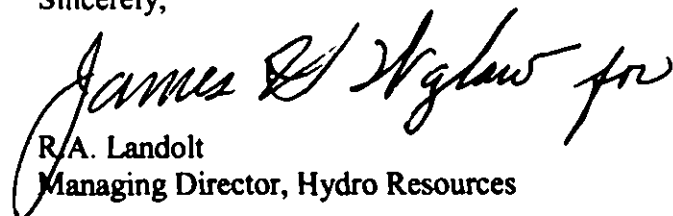
By Order Granting Surrender Application and Approving Project Removal Plan; American Fork Hydroelectric Project FERC No. 0696: 108FERC ¶61,130; August 4, 2004, permission was granted to decommission our American Fork Hydroelectric Project. Your letter dated July 10, 2007 approved the start of the decommissioning process, and requested monthly reports of our progress. Attached is our monthly report for August 2007.

To date, we have:

- Completed project permitting;
- Conducted a pre-construction & safety meeting to provide a detailed explanation of the planned work, coordination among the parties present, and formal review and discussion of safety policies and issues specific to this project;
- Begun disassembly of the turbine-generator.;
- Installed new wiring in the powerhouse to facilitate its renovation;
- Removed the operator residence and garage as well as tree overgrowth in order to allow construction of the decommissioning plan's features;
- Cut approximately 1000 linear feet of 28-inch diameter steel flowline pipe into sections in preparation for removal;
- Trained on-site project personnel in cultural resource compliance to help them identify and respond appropriately if potential resources should be uncovered during the project; and
- Trained on-site personnel in project-specific safety, spill prevention and containment.
