PROCEDURE USED:

- 1) A training meeting was held for all clothing leaders on fabric selection for a particular pattern; and color selection was also included. From information gathered at this meeting, the leaders were able to help the girls decide on the fabric for their project. A color kit was used to demonstrate how they might teach color selection to these girls.
- 2) I visited the leaders who were unable to attend the meeting to give them the information.
- 3) I attended project meetings of new leaders to assist them, also attended experienced leaders project meetings when requested.
- 4) Information on clothing and textiles has been included in the "Home Ec Digest" which is sent to all Home Economics leaders as well as other local people who have requested it.
- 5) 4-H leaders assisted the judges in any way possible at the County and District Fairs.
- 6) In addition to the 4-H clothing project material, I have given the leaders clothing information from the distribution files.
- 7) News articles on clothing and textiles have been given to the four local newspapers.

8) Accessory selection and grooming training has been given at a countywide training meeting for the members, leaders, and interested parents. Training was also given in walking and posture correction at this meeting.

RESULTS:

- 1) 4-H leaders found assisting judges at fairs very helpful in working with the members. They became aware of the importance of clothing construction techniques.
- 2) Leaders are acquainted with the Textile Fiber Products Identification Act.
- 3) The comments on the Clothing Score Cards has aided members and leaders with construction techniques.
- 4) As a result of the County Dress Revue Training Meeting, we had more confident and poised models at the annual event.

CONCLUSION:

The clothing leaders are constantly increasing their knowledge of clothing and textiles, and do pass some of the information on to the 4-H clothing members.
