On February 27th, 1975 a National Advisory Board on Infant Mental Health was established and the first meeting was held at the Mental Health Study Center of NIMH. (I have been appointed to this Board.) Participants at the meeting were six program directors and researchers representing Harvard, Yale, University of Michigan, Jewish Board of Guardians and ten NIMH and NICHD officers. (See attached list).

The program objectives for development of infant mental health clinical and research facilities are very largely those which we had first proposed to The Grant Foundation, Commonwealth and Johnson two years ago, and the Board, as you will see is essentially composed of the members of that first Inter-University Committee on Infant Mental Health. We are all pleased. In the end this program is better placed in NIMH where it can be institutionalized than in a consortium of Foundations.

I will try to summarize the main outcomes of this meeting:

- (1) The Advisory Board will serve as consultants to the NIMH Mental Health Study Center in setting up their intramural demonstration and research programs in infant mental health.
- (2) The advisory board will offer leadership in the development of a national network of infant mental health programs
- (3) The institutions represented on the Board will develop, with NIMH assistance, programs of exchange of clinical and research experience and NIMH will provide a coordinator and staff to facilitate exchange and program development.

- (4) Plans for training of infant mental health specialists will begin within the institutions represented on the Board, with mutually supporting and complementary programs, exchange of faculty and trainees.
- (5) NIMH, NICHD and Maternal and Child Health will pool their own resources in staff and funding in order to get start-up funds and personnel in this otherwise bad year for mental health and children.
- (6) The NIMH Study Center, which administers the Community Mental Health Program is, itself, in a better financial situation than other agencies, and is in a position to give priorities to infant mental health in its own funding, which will exert pressure on grant recipients to develop infant programs.
- (7) The establishment of the Board and the program outlined have the blessings of Bert Brown and we are told that babies will have the highest priority in NIMH allocation of funds and resources.

Dear Mrs. Carter:

We are writing to you on behalf of 10 million babies in our nation who are, as yet, voiceless citizens in our new President's constituency.

At least one out of every four of these 10 million babies may never fulfill his human potential because he has been deprived, in some measure, of the vital nutriment for psychological health during the critical first three years of life. In our opinion babies constitute the largest endangered population in our country from the mental health point of view. Yet the presentation and cure of emotional impairment in infancy resides in our science and can be brought to babies today.

We know of your own great interest and your work in mental health. It is our hope that our new First Lady may wish to take leadership in establishing the rights of infants as our nation's highest priority. Your moral and intellectual authority as a spokesman for the babies could arouse the people of our nation to the imperative needs of infants and the imperative needs of our society, to give every baby the full measure of his human potential, for love and for learning.

May we ask for an opportunity to talk with you about the critical issues in infancy as we see them in our research and clinical experience?
