TULARE CENTER ARIZONA BOUND

GILA RIVER RELOCATION CENTER IS DESTINATION

The Center Management and the Commissioners are now making preliminary arrangements for evacuation of this Center to Gila River Relocation Center, which, according to tentative plans, will take place the latter part of August, announced Center Manager Nils Aanonsen.

The Gila River Center, which is located southeast of Phoenix, Arizona, is already being occupied by the Turlock Assembly Centerites. According to advance reports, it has a very healthy climate, and is not for only a few months out of the year.

Tentative plans for the removal of this Center will be discussed by the Commissioners and Councilmen on Friday. The entire Center will be moved out by units of 500, with one group leaving every day. Certain key workers will form the last group to leave here. It will take ten days to complete evacuation.

It will take about two days and a night for the 800 mile trip to the new Relocation Center.
