AMENDMENT TO CUYUNA ORDINANCES
GENERAL REQUIREMENTS, SUBD. 10: USE OF ROADS

The Council of the City of Cuyuna, Minnesota, ordains:

Speed Limits. The speed limit on all city streets and alleys in the original City of Cuyuna, including, but not limited to, namely, North, Foley, Main, Kruse and South Streets; and Chicago, Roosevelt and Tripp Avenues; shall be 15 miles per hour. The speed limit on Agate Shores Road, Cottontail Drive, and other roads outside the central original City of Cuyuna shall be 20 miles per hour.

Provisions of State Law Adopted. The provisions of Minnesota Statutes, § 169.14, Subd. 2, relating to Speed Limits ("the speed limit within any municipality shall be a maximum limit and any speed in excess thereof shall be unlawful") are adopted and incorporated herein by reference.

Penalty. Any person violating any provision of this ordinance is guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$700 or imprisonment in the county jail for not more than 90 days, or both, plus the cost of prosecution in any case.

Repeal or Amendment. Inconsistent ordinances, if any, are repealed, and the Cuyuna Zoning Ordinance, Section 9, General Requirements, Subds. 1-9 is hereby amended by this Subdivision 10.

Effective Date. This ordinance becomes effective upon its passage and publication according to law.
