AMENDMENT TO ARTICLE II and ARTICLE IV OF THE CUYUNA SUBDIVISION
ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, the Cuyuna provisions for specifications for cul-de-sacs must be clarified to ensure consistent interpretation,

THEREFORE, The City of Cuyuna Ordains:

Article II, Section 1 - Definitions Cuyuna Subdivision Ordinance "Cul-De-Sac" is repealed AND AMENDED as follows;

Cul-De-Sac: A comparatively short street having but one end open to traffic and the other end being permanently terminated by a vehicular turn around; that turn around minimum right of way being not less than a 66-foot radius and a minimum surfacing/pavement of not less than a 46-foot radius.

Article IV, Section 5 Dead End Streets Cuyuna Subdivision Ordinance "Cul-De-Sac" is repealed AND AMENDED as follows;

Section 5 - Dead End Streets

The creation of dead end or loop residential streets will be encouraged wherever the Planning Commission finds this type of street development will not interfere with normal traffic circulation in the area, and shall have a cul-De-Sac right of way of not less than a 66-foot radius and a minimum surfacing/pavement of not less than a 46-foot radius.
