ORDINANCE 805A.
NUISANCE MOTOR VEHICLES
AMENDMENT TO CUYUNA NUISANCE ORDINANCE NO. 95-805

An Ordinance Defining, Prohibiting and Providing Penalty for Violations Thereof

The City of Cuyuna ordains:

SECTION 4. Public Nuisances Affecting Peace and Safety. The following are declared to be nuisances affecting peace and safety:

- (19) Any motor vehicle placed, parked, permitted to remain, stored, or left in an open space area of any premises located anywhere in the City, unless it conforms with all of the following requirements:
 1. The vehicle must have affixed a valid current motor vehicle license and tabs;
 2. The vehicle must not lack essential parts that would render it inoperable;
 3. The vehicle must not be in a rusted, wrecked, partially dismantled or junked condition;
 4. The vehicle must not be open to entry;
 5. Vehicle must not be improperly parked on an unapproved surface;
 6. The vehicle must not be missing vital component parts; and
 7. The vehicle must not be on private property without the proper consent of the owner.

SECTION 5A. Duties of city officers (Continued). Aiding in the enforcement of any of the provisions of the Cuyuna Nuisance Ordinance may be carried out by any authorized agent of the City. Irregularities in inspection, enforcement, notices of nuisances, service of notices, notices of hearing, hearing, administration, abatement, collection of fees, cost recovery, and imposition of liens on real property shall not render any action invalid, so long as said action conforms to the reasonable principles of due process, notice and hearing, administratively or judicially, of the state and federal constitutions, Minnesota Statutes, and Minnesota Statute 429.101, or as amended.

SUMMARY OF CUYUNA NUISANCE ORDINANCE AMENDMENT NO. 805A

The following official summary has been approved by the city council of Cuyuna as clearly informing the public of the intent and effect of this ordinance. It is the intent and effect of the ordinance to adopt by reference statutes relating to the prevention of nuisances; to prohibit nuisances; to assess the cost of elimination of public health and safety nuisances; and to provide a penalty for violation.

SECTION 4. The following will henceforth be declared Nuisance Conditions which affect Peace and Safety:

Any motor vehicle placed in an open space with

No current motor vehicle license and tabs;

Lacking essential parts that would render it inoperable

Having rusted, wrecked, partially dismantled or junked condition
Open to entry

Appearing undriveable

Improperly parked on an unapproved surface

Dismantled

Missing vital component parts; or

On private property without the proper consent of the owner

SECTION 5A. Duties of city officers. Aiding in the enforcement of any of the provisions of the Cuyuna Nuisance Ordinance may be carried out by any authorized agent of the City.

A printed copy of the ordinance is available for inspection by any person at the office of the city clerk.

Cuyuna Ordinance No. 95-805, is hereby amended.

Effective Date. This ordinance becomes effective upon its passage and publication according to law.
