CUYUNA ORDINANCE 702.
AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING UNREASONABLE ACCELERATION, AND
PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR VIOLATION

The Council of the City of Cuyuna, Minnesota, ordains:

- (a) *Definitions.* The following words, terms and phrases, when used in this section shall have the meanings ascribed to them in this subsection, except where the context clearly indicates a different meaning:

Unreasonable acceleration of a motor vehicle means accelerating without apparent reason, and accomplishment in such manner as to cause squealing or screeching sounds by the tires or the throwing of sand or gravel by the tires of the vehicle or both. Prima facie evidence of such unnecessary and unreasonable acceleration shall be squealing or screeching sounds emitted by the tires, or the throwing of sand or gravel by the tires of the vehicle, or both.
- (b) *Prohibited.* Unreasonable acceleration of any motor vehicle on any public or private road or way within the city is declared to be a public nuisance and is prohibited.
- (c) *Punishment.* Any person violating any provision of this ordinance is guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$700 or imprisonment in the county jail for not more than 90 days, or both, plus the cost of prosecution in any case.

Effective Date. This ordinance becomes effective upon its passage and publication according to law.

Unreasonable acceleration of any motor vehicle on any public or private road or way within the city is declared to be a public nuisance and is prohibited.
