

**ORDINANCE 402B**

AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING An amendment to the Cuyuna Ordinances, namely, Subsurface Sewage Treatment System (SSTS) Provisions.

It is the intent and effect of the ordinance to adopt, enact, or incorporate by reference Crow Wing County Ordinances at the County=s AArticle 37 Subsurface Sewage Treatment Systems, Technical Standards and Criteria;@ that is, provisions 37.01 through 37.32 of Crow Wing County Ordinances, either by setting them out in full in the official records of the City of Cuyuna, or by incorporating them therein by referring to the Crow Wing County Records as if set out in full.

These provisions are amendments, additions and changes to the Subsurface Sewage Treatment System (SSTS) ordinance. Per Minnesota Statute 115.55, subd. 2, all jurisdictions need to amend their ordinances to include the 2014 PMCA SSTS Rules, and it is the intent of the City of Cuyuna to proceed accordingly. In addition, the PMCA SSTS rules, as amended, shall be included in Cuyuna provisions in the future.

This ordinance includes provisions and regulations in the following categories:

Intent; Jurisdiction; Effective Date; Scope; Administration; Liability; All SSTS; Existing Permits; SSTS on Lots Created After January 23, 1996; Upgrade, Repair, Replacement and Abandonment SSTS in Floodplains; Class V Injection Wells; SSTS Practitioner Licensing; Prohibitions; Permit Requirements; Transfer of Property, and more.

REPEAL. Any inconsistent provisions in any of the Cuyuna Ordinances, in the Zoning Code, or in Ordinance No. 402A, are hereby repealed.

EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance becomes effective upon its passage and publication according to law.
