

# HOW TO USE THIS VIDEO CURRICULUM

Here is a brief explanation of the features of this study guide.

### **CHECKING IN:**

You will open each meeting with an opportunity for everyone to check in with each other about how you are doing with the weekly assignments. Accountability is a key to success in this study!

### **KEY VERSE:**

Each week you will find a key verse or Scripture passage for your group to read together. If someone in the group has a different translation, ask them to read it aloud so the group can get a bigger picture of the meaning of the passage.

### **VIDEO LESSON:**

There is a video lesson for the group to watch together each week. Fill in the blanks in the lesson outlines as you watch the video, and be sure to refer back to these outlines during your discussion time.





### **DISCOVERY QUESTIONS:**

Each video segment is complemented by several questions for group discussion. Please don't feel pressured to discuss every single question. There is no reason to rush through the answers. Give everyone ample opportunity to share their thoughts. If you don't get through all of the discussion guestions, that's okay.

### **PUTTING IT INTO PRACTICE:**

This is where the rubber meets the road. We don't want to be just hearers of the Word. We also need to be doers of the Word (James 1:22). These assignments are application exercises that will help you put into practice the truths you have discussed in the lesson.

### PRAYER DIRECTION:

At the end of each session you will find suggestions for your group prayer time. Praying together is one of the greatest privileges of small group life. Please don't take it for granted.

### A TIP FOR THE HOST:

The study guide material is meant to be your servant, not your master. The point is not to race through the sessions; the point is to take time to let God work in your lives. Nor is it necessary to "go around the circle" before you move on to the next question. Give people the freedom to speak, but don't insist on it. Your group will enjoy deeper, more open sharing and discussion if people don't feel pressured to speak up.

We're beginning a study of how God tested Daniel through every stage of his life, from his teenage years all the way into retirement. And the practical lessons from Daniel's story will help every one of us to stand firm in our beliefs and develop a greater trust in God.

Why should he see you looking worse than the other young men your age? The king would then have my head because of you."

Daniel then said to the guard whom the chief official had appointed over Daniel, Hananiah, Mishael and Azariah, "Please test your servants for ten days: Give us nothing but vegetables to eat and water to drink. Then compare our appearance with that of the young men who eat the royal food, and treat your servants in accordance with what you see." So he agreed to this and tested them for ten days.

At the end of the ten days they looked healthier and better nourished than any of the young men who ate the royal food. So the guard took away their choice food and the wine they were to drink and gave them vegetables instead . . . At the end of the time set by the king to bring them into his service, the chief official presented them to Nebuchadnezzar. The king talked with them, and he found none equal to Daniel, Hananiah, Mishael and Azariah; so they entered the king's service.

### **DISCOVERY QUESTIONS:**

1.)	God's Word teaches us that before every blessing, there's a testing. How have you experienced this in your own life? What's an example of a time that God tested you with stress before he trusted you with success? How did going through that stressful situation affect the way you handled your success?
2.)	Of the "4 Qualities That God Looks for in Your Life" (integrity, discipline, courage, and humility), which one do you struggle with the most? What might help you get stronger in this area? How is your struggle related to your trust in God?
3.)	Have you ever needed to make an appeal to an authority, asking for a decision to be changed? How did it go? How might you do it differently now that you have learned the way Daniel made an appeal?





### **PUTTING IT INTO PRACTICE:**

Exodus 23:2 teaches us to "Never follow the crowd in doing wrong" (GW). What crowds in your life may tempt you to do the wrong thing? Why are you tempted to follow them?
How will this lesson help you to stand firm on God's truth? How can you apply what you've learned in this lesson to situations where you are tempted to follow the crowd?

### PRAYER DIRECTION:

In your group prayer time and then on your own:

- Ask God to help you develop into a Daniel in your world, trusting in God no matter what your situation, no matter how much pressure you are under.
- Tell God you want him to develop each of these characteristics in you: integrity, humility, discipline, and courage. Take time to pray about each of these specifically and individually.
- Tell God you give him permission to do whatever it takes to help you become unafraid and unashamed, submitted to do whatever he asks you to do.
