




3. Tobi asanoha (Scattered Hemp Leaf)



A favorite pattern of mine, this Sashiko stitch pattern is the most well known. Sashiko was originally stitched on hemp cloth, as cotton was not grown in the region of Japan where this styling style began. Hemp is considered a plant of strength and this design is a symbol of wishes for prosperity.

The dashed lines should be transferred to the front of your fabric as a solid line. The solid lines can be transferred, but should not be stitched.
