







The persimmon blossom is considered a "Hitomezashi" stitch design. It consists of 1 stitch, worked in a grid formation. To me, this one was a bit trickier because it looks best when the stitches are as consistent in size as you can get them.

The dashed lines should be transferred to the front of your fabric as a solid line. The solid lines can be transferred, but should not be stitched. They are for reference only.

Makes one coaster that finishes at 4" square.
