

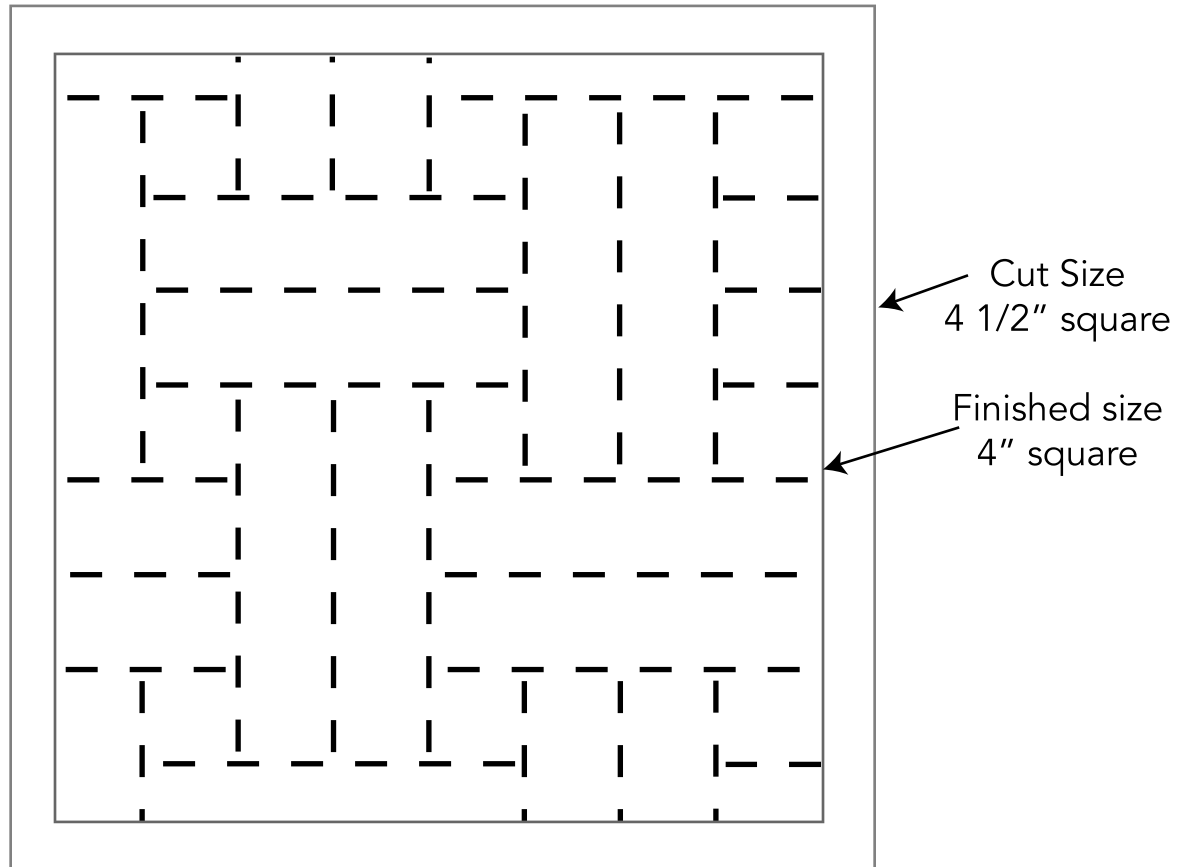

1. Ishidatami (Paving Block)



This Sashiko stitch pattern mimics a paved walkway, or woven basket.

One of the group of "Moyozashi" stitch patterns. The most obvious characteristic of this pattern group is that the stitches do not ever cross each other or touch.

The dashed lines should be transferred to the front of your fabric as a solid line. The solid lines can be transferred, but should not be stitched.

They are for reference only.

1" x 1"

Makes one coaster that finishes at 4" square.
