Strawberry Banana Pudding Cake

+ Sweetly Whipped Strawberry
Cream + Strawberry
Lemon Soda



strawberry banana pudding cake

chop + measure + cut

Chop 1-2 ripe strawberries into a small dice. Measure and cut 1½ T from a stick of butter.

coat + microwave

Coat the inside of your mug with the butter and drop the rest of the butter in the bottom of the microwave-safe mug. Microwave for 30 seconds to melt the butter. (While butter is melting, clean your clappers!)

measure + crack + whisk

Measure 2 T brown sugar, 1/4 tsp vanilla extract, and 2 T Greek yogurt to the melted butter. Crack 1 egg and add to the mug. Whisk to combine everything!







peel + mash + mix

Peel **1 super ripe banana** and mash it on a plate or in your cereal bowl with a fork or small whisk. Mash it well! Mix mashed banana and chopped strawberries into your mug.

measure + add + mix

Measure and add ¼ C all-purpose or whole wheat flour, ¼ tsp baking powder, and a pinch of salt to your mug. Mix again!

cover + heat + check

Cover mug with a **damp paper towel** and microwave on high for 2 minutes. After 2 minutes, carefully check your mug cake by poking a toothpick in the center. If it doesn't come out clean, microwave for another minute!

Mug cakes are like molten lava straight out of the microwave. Carefully wait a few minutes to let them cool while you make your drink.

sweetly whipped strawberry cream

chop + sprinkle + mix

Chop **2 ripe strawberries** into tiny pieces. Add to a bowl, sprinkle a big pinch of sugar over them, and mix to coat the strawberries in sugar. Set aside.

measure + pour + shake

Measure and pour 1/4 C of heavy whipping cream to a pint-sized glass or plastic jar and seal with the lid. With one hand over the lid and the other holding the jar, start shaking the jar back and forth, up and down, round and round and side to side! Your cream will start to thicken after about 20-30 seconds of shaking. Check it! You want your cream to be thick but not as thick as butter.

peel + mash + mix

Add your chopped strawberries, their juices, and a small pinch of salt to the jar. Stir to combine. Top your Strawberry Banana Pudding Cake with Sweetly Whipped Strawberry Cream, CHEERS with your So Bubbly Strawberry Lemon Soda, and ENJOY!

so bubbly strawberry lemon soda

Fill a drinking glass with 1 C ice. Add sugared strawberries to glass. Pour sparkling water over all of it, and stir! Cheers!

Strawberries!

- ★ Strawberries are a HUGE source of Vitamin C, especially when eaten raw!
- ★ Vitamin C is wonderful for the heart, bones, and teeth. When we cut ourselves or break a bone, Vitamin C comes to the rescue to help repair our tissues.
