

## Easy steps on how to light your fire



### Step 1

Place 6-8 sticks of kindling just like a Jenga, and place a single Flamer into the middle.



### Step 2

Take about 2-3 of the smaller logs and place over the kindling.



### Step 3

Light the Flamer firelighter and allow the fire to burn for about 5-10 minutes.

**Tip: Don't be tempted to move any logs, just leave it to burn**



### Step 4

Add more logs as required to build a really good base to the fire.

**Tip: Always add more logs at a vertical angle making sure there are always plenty of air gaps between them.**

### Stay Safe and observe the countryside rules

- Always keep the fire confined to the designated areas.
- Do not build the fire too large.
- BEWARE of Carbon Monoxide – DO NOT put charcoal on the fire in a Tipi or Yurt.
- DO NOT collect wood from the hedgerows as this is PRIVATE PROPERTY.
- If the fire becomes out of control use Fire Extinguisher.
