

## Eighth Grade Information

**The Parma City School District offers the following 8th grade sports:**

Fall-Football, Volleyball, B/G Cross-Country, Cheerleading  
Winter-B/G Basketball, Wrestling, Cheerleading  
Spring-B/G Track

The pay-to-participate fee for middle school sports is \$100.00 per sport. There is an \$900 family cap per school year. Checks should be made payable to the Parma City Schools. The fee must be paid prior to the first scrimmage or game.

There may also be a uniform fee depending on the sport. If there is a uniform fee, then the uniform is considered personal property and is owned by the athlete.

The 8th grade sports teams will be practicing and competing at Shiloh Middle School. During August and on non-school days, transportation to/from practice must be provided by the parents. On school days, 8th grade student-athletes will be transported after school from PSH to Shiloh for practices and games and will need to be picked up at Shiloh afterwards by their parents.

All student-athletes must turn in a valid physical exam prior to first day of practice. They must also turn in the athletics paperwork packet.
