

# NCAA Eligibility

If you are a student athlete and you are considering playing NCAA sports in college, you will need to make sure you meet minimum requirements and follow the steps outlined below.

Minimum GPA requirements to fully qualify:

Division I: 2.3

Division II: 2.2

Minimum SAT or ACT score requirements will vary based on your GPA.

## NCAA Eligibility – To Do List

1. Register for the NCAA Eligibility Center (11<sup>th</sup> Grade Spring Semester)

2. Request a transcript to be sent to the NCAA Eligibility Center.

Obtain a Transcript Request Form from the Counseling Office.

Complete the form, have your parent sign the form, and return it to the Counseling Office.

3. Take the SAT or ACT and request scores to be sent to NCAA Eligibility Center (using code 9999).

4. Request a FINAL transcript to be sent to NCAA Eligibility Center.

You may do this before your last day on campus and the Counseling/Records Office staff will send the transcript once final grades post.
