

QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS ABOUT NORTH HIGH ATHLETICS

What do I need to do to be able to play sports at North High?

Fill out the entire athletic clearance packet. These are available on the Saxon Athletic website (saxonathletics.com). The packet will only be accepted if all forms are completed.

This packet includes:

- Physical exam (Exam date AFTER June 1st 2021)
- Insurance form (you can use your own or buy insurance from Myers-Stevens)
- Warning of possible injury
- Parents permission and medical release
- Substance abuse/Steroid use
- Opioids Information Sheet
- Athletic Information Sheet (CIF requirements)
- Transportation contributions:

1	student in one activity/team	\$130
1	student in 2 or more activities/team	\$200
2	students each in one activity/team	\$260
2	or more students in three activities/team	\$300
3	students in one activity/team	\$300
2	or more students in 2 or more activities/teams	\$300

What is meant by the term “academic eligibility”?

All 9th grade students are automatically eligible for the first grading period. All other students involved in extracurricular activities must earn at least a 2.0 GPA (“C” average) and *not have more than 1 unsatisfactory citizenship grade every quarter.*

Do freshman play only on the Frosh or Frosh/Soph teams?

In most sports yes. But, if an athlete is good enough and the coach deems it appropriate, he/she can play at a higher level.

How is money raised for each sport?

Each sport is essentially unfunded by the district. Each sport must fundraise during the year to provide for the high cost of running athletic programs. Expect to pay or fundraise every cost associated with athletics while at North High. In addition to individual fundraising, the Athletics Booster Club works year-round to support our entire sports program by hosting many fundraising events and workdays. They hold annual pancake breakfasts, pasta nights, and more. Their annual dues go directly to the sports program. Your support in our Booster Club is absolutely necessary for our success.
