## **Woodland Conference's Traditional Fall Sports Details**

**Milwaukee, WI (Sept 8, 2020)** -- The Woodland Conference Schools have been meeting over the past weeks and have concluded today plans around the traditional fall sports programs (girls' tennis, boys'/girls' cross country, girls' golf, girls' swim and dive, boys' soccer and football).

Brown Deer, Cudahy, Greendale, Greenfield, Milwaukee Lutheran, Shorewood (along with co-op Messmer in football), South Milwaukee, West Allis Central and Whitnall will play boys' soccer and football in the alternate season. Pius XI Catholic and Wisconsin Lutheran play football in the alternate season. These schools, along with West Allis Nathan Hale being welcomed into the Alternate-Season Woodland Groupings, will form a 10-team boys' soccer schedule and a two-division six-team schedule in football.

The following conference schools will participate in the traditional fall boys' soccer season: New Berlin Eisenhower, New Berlin West, Pewaukee, Pius XI Catholic and Wisconsin Lutheran. The Woodland Conference will have a five-team conference schedule with one school having a conference bye for each date. In soccer, the alternate-season grouping will play each school once in the nine-game conference schedule and one non-conference matchup to conclude the year against a like opponent.

In football, the following Parkland-grouping of schools will participate in the traditional fall season: Catholic Memorial, New Berlin Eisenhower, New Berlin West, Pewaukee, Wauwatosa East and Wauwatosa West. The Parkland-football grouping will welcome Grafton for 2020. The seven-school grouping will play each other with one school having a conference bye each week.

In football, the alternate-season grouping Red Division will be Brown Deer, Milwaukee Lutheran, Pius XI Catholic, Shorewood, West Allis Central and Wisconsin Lutheran. The Gray Division will be Cudahy, Greendale, Greenfield, South Milwaukee, West Allis Nathan Hale and Whitnall. Each school will play once in their division for a five-game conference schedule. The final two weeks will include match-up crossover games.

All Woodland Conference Schools, as well as West Allis Nathan Hale, have been working on updating their schedules on woodlandconference.org (and greatermetroconference.org). We appreciate your patience as all schedules may not be 100 percent updated at this time but many are very close. In a short time, all woodlandconference.org (and greatermetroconference.org for Hale) schedules will be updated.

As [released on August 20, 2020](#), all Woodland Conference schools are participating in the sports of girls' tennis, boys'/girls' cross country, girls' golf and girls' swim and dive.
