

Seneca Valley High School Virtual Sports Registration 2020

Registration for the Winter Virtual Season is open, please [register via the Google Form and](#) see the full detailed information from SVHS Athletics below. The Winter virtual season will start on October 26th and end on December 4th. please reach out to [Mr. Jesse Irvin](#) and the coaches listed below to get more information. There will be Spring Virtual Season and information about those along with sign-up links will be posted closer to those seasons.

The high school interscholastic athletics virtual program is available to all students at the high school level – no cuts. The high school virtual athletics season consists of a minimum of three student-athlete and coach engagement sessions per week (corollary sports will meet two times per week), over the course of five weeks. Coaches may schedule engagement sessions beginning 15 minutes post school/duty day until 9 p.m. and from 9 a.m. – 3 p.m. on Saturdays. With principal (or designee) approval, engagement sessions may be conducted outside of these windows of time. The Winter virtual season is scheduled to occur between October 26th – December 4th, 2020. All students participating in the winter virtual season, as part of the MCPS interscholastic athletics program, must complete the online registration process. Registration is done electronically through the [Jesse Irvin HS Athletics Registration form](#). Students must have a valid physical on file with the school. Given the unprecedented circumstances, for students who are unable to secure an updated physical, **MCPS will extend the expiration date of an existing physical by one calendar year**. To the extent a student does not have a physical on file with the school, the student will need to obtain one. Due to the strenuous nature of selected activities, each student is encouraged to consult their physician concerning fitness to participate in the program. During any live engagement, parents/guardians and students must ensure that surroundings are free of obstacles and that an appropriate plan is in place on how to access help in the event of an emergency.
