

Swansea High School Hall of Fame



1. The purpose of the Hall of Fame is to recognize both Players and Coaches who have had outstanding achievements in athletics, as well as Athletic Supporters who have demonstrated commitment and excellence in athletic service to Lexington School District Four (including Swansea High School and Monroe Pinckney High). A Hall of Fame Player or Coach nominee must have received awards above the All- Region or All-Conference level in athletics. An Athletic Supporter nominee must have demonstrated devoted volunteer service to enrich the athletic community. Player nominees must be ***fifteen years*** removed from graduation, Coach nominees must be ***retired*** or ***five years*** removed from employment with Lexington School District Four. Athletic Supporter nominees must have ***at least ten years*** of service. No more than 5 selections will be made per year.
2. The Swansea High School Athletic Department will form a committee of 5-7 members to review all nominations. The committee will consist of at minimum a representative from Athletic Administration at Swansea High School, a Lexington School District Four administrator, a Lexington School District Four teacher, a Hall of Fame member, and the president of the Booster Club. After review, the committee will select the inductees for the Hall of Fame. Any nominee not chosen for the Hall of Fame will have their qualifications kept for consideration the following year.
3. Candidates for the Hall of Fame must be nominated by the annual deadline. The nominator is responsible for supplying the Hall of Fame Committee with documentation to justify the candidate's placement in the Hall of Fame. Nominating information should include all relevant statistics, awards and recognitions.
4. The winners each year will be recognized at a home football game. Inductees will be given complimentary tickets to the football game (amount TBD each year depending on the number of electees).
5. A plaque for Hall of Fame inductees will be displayed at Swansea High School. The Hall of Fame Members will also receive a plaque. The school's athletic website will have a page with pictures and information for each member.
6. Anyone who wishes to nominate a candidate to the Hall of Fame must acquire a nominating form from the Swansea High School Athletics Director. All nominations must be returned to Swansea High School Athletics Department by the designated due date for each upcoming year. No late entries will be accepted.
