PLEASE NOTE: The Athletic Dept. will now only be ordering patches three (3) times per school year. **Order deadlines for the 2022-23 Fall Sports season is December 16.** Other order deadlines are: March 16 and June 16. **Patch orders must be submitted to the Athletic Dept. with payment by these dates or they will be held until the next order date.**

The Athletic Dept. will purchase the highest level tournament patch earned for each IHSAA tournament team. The Athletic Dept. will also purchase a patch for each individual State Qualifier.

The Athletic Dept. will not automatically order these patches. Any student-athlete who qualifies for one of the patches listed above, must still submit an order form. All other patches must be paid for by the student-athlete prior to the patch being ordered.

All awards are considered the property of Adams Central High School until an athlete has graduated. The school reserves the right to revoke any award for any violation of athletic, scholastic, or citizenship rules or regulations. In all cases, an athlete must be in good standing to qualify for an award. In the event of injury, illness, or unusual circumstances, the final decision concerning awards will be made by the coach.

1. Numerals - any freshman athlete successfully completing the sport season and upon recommendation from his/her coach will qualify for a numeral monogram. This monogram will be awarded at the end of the season in which the athlete earned this numeral. Any athlete can earn only one set of numerals during freshman year.
2. Minor Awards (Junior Varsity) - all players participating in a sport but who do not qualify for a varsity award will earn a minor award certificate of participation. There is no limit to how many certificates a student may earn.
3. Varsity Awards - a varsity letter monogram will be awarded to an athlete who successfully meets the major award requirements for the sport in which he/she participates. Only one major letter will be awarded during the athlete's career, and it will be awarded at the sports banquet following the sport in which it was earned. When an athlete majors (letters) for the first time in a sport, the AC patch and a chevron with an emblem of that sport will be awarded. For every successive letter earned, a certificate and a plain chevron will be awarded.
4. All awards will be awarded at the discretion of the coach in charge.
5. Students who are dropped from a squad forfeit all rights to an award in the respective sport. If a student quits a team, he/she forfeits all rights to an award.
