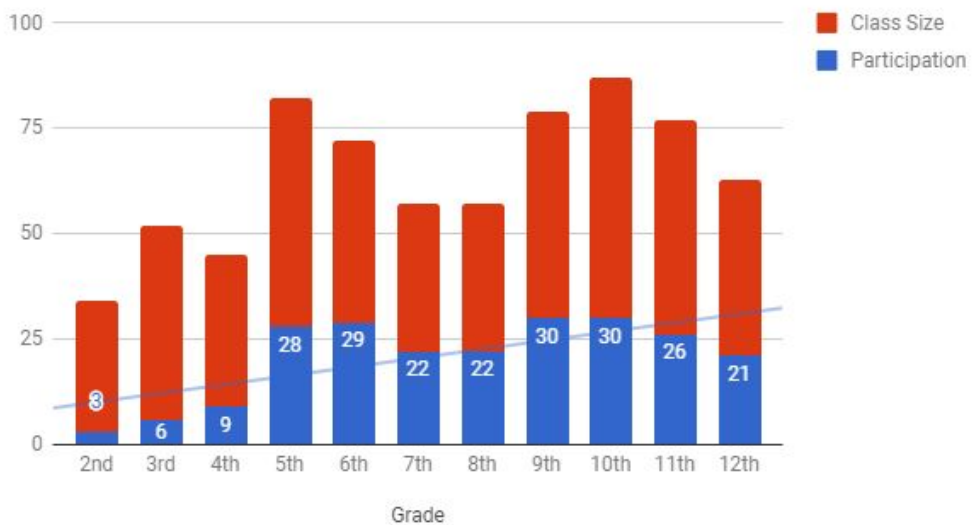

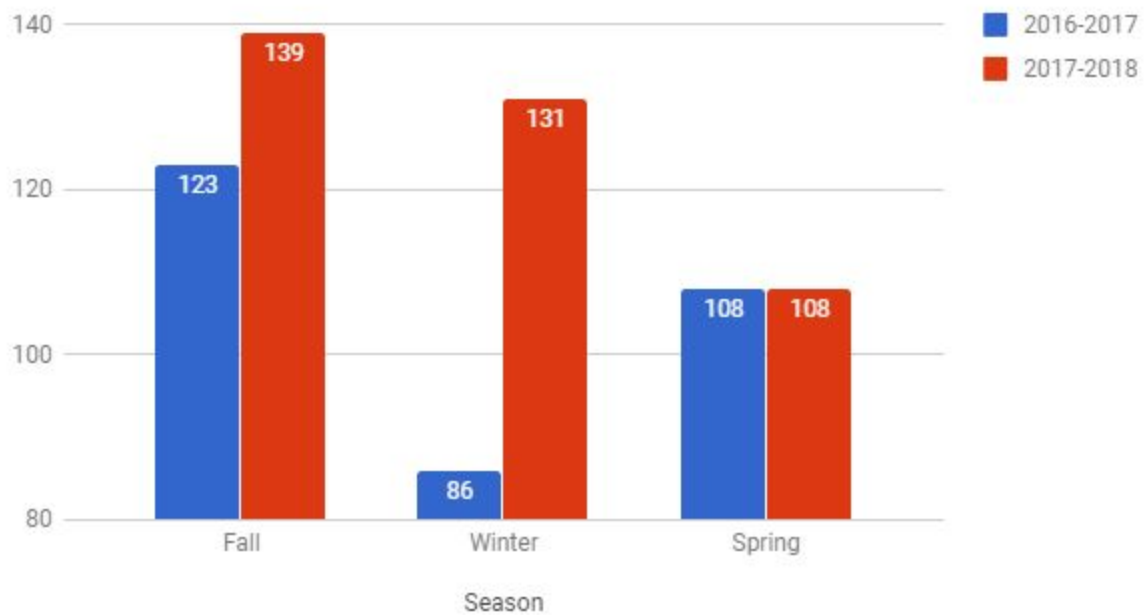
2017-2018 Participation and Class Size

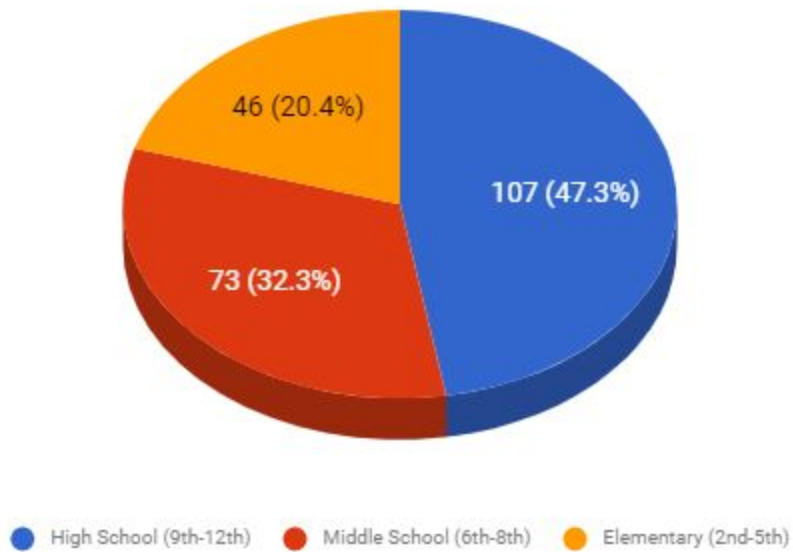
Sport Participation: 2016-17 vs. 2017-18



Participation by Year and Grade Level

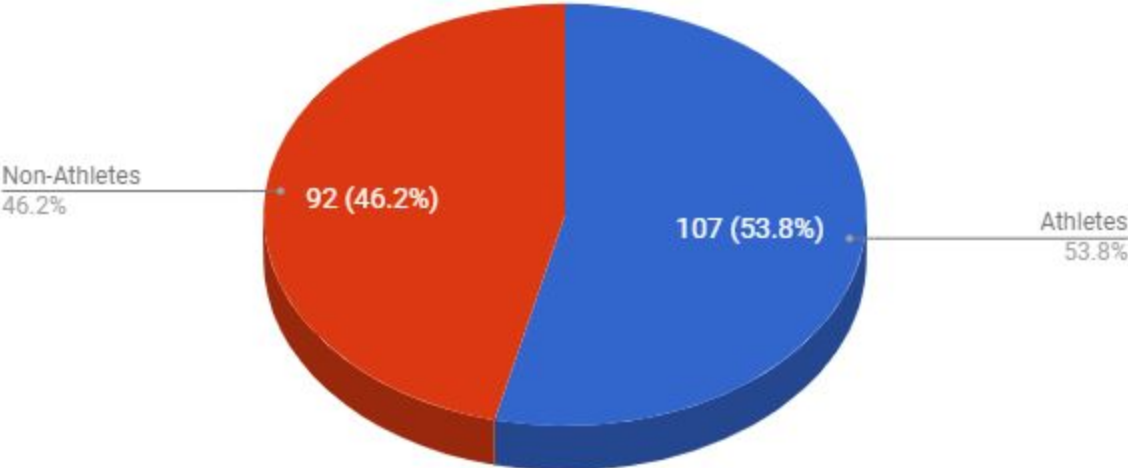

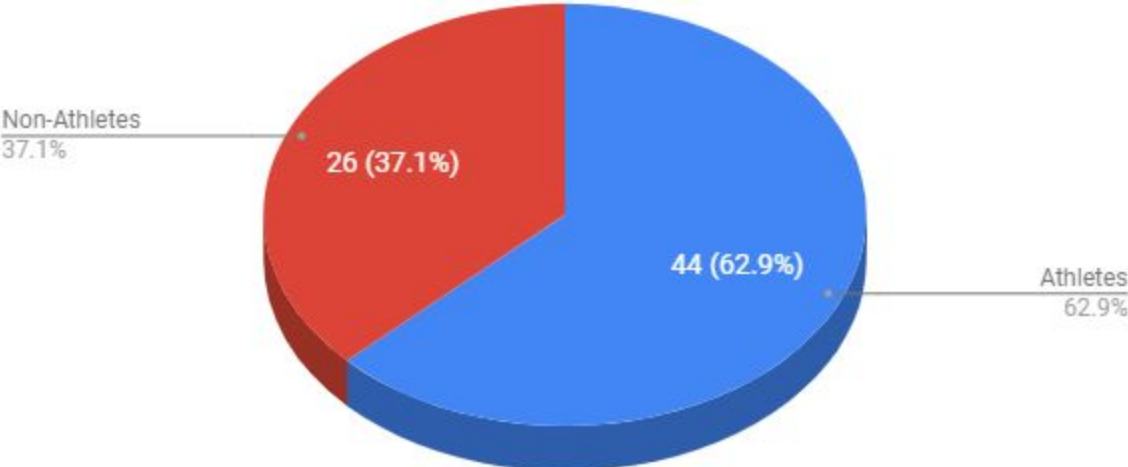


Participation by Building
