## Sports Medicine Information:

- School Office Hours: 12:00PM-4:00PM (Game days)  
12:00PM-8:00PM (Practice days)
- Parents will be notified when child is injured and/or receiving treatment/referral or pulled from sport practice/game
- Diagnosed concussions will be treated by the ATC and referred if further evaluation/treatment is needed.
  - Students may not be excused from school/PE/homework unless a MD has issued a note to the athletic trainer or school nurse
- Treatment during school:
  - Athletes are not to see the nurse for treatment of pre-existing athletic injuries during school unless ATC has notified the nurse (i.e., ice therapy)
- Treatments after school:
  - Only athletes with severe injuries or injuries that require therapeutic intervention before activity are to see ATC for treatment before practice
  - There will be no treatments on game day unless instructed by ATC
- Insurance:
  - See athletic trainer for Insurance Claims form immediately following referral (must be filed within 90 days after injury)
- Referrals:
  - Wren High School has a standing contract with Bon Secours Mercy Health, meaning the ATC has 24/7 access to sports medicine doctors in the BSMH network and can refer injuries the following day
  - You are welcome to use your own PCP however communication between the ATC and other hospital networks is non-existent
- Illness/ COVID:
  - If your child is attending class at Wren they are to see the school nurse for all illnesses
  - If your child is attending online-only class they are to report at the beginning of each practice at check-ins, they will be sent home if not feeling well or exhibiting one of the three symptoms with or without a fever with no known exposure to a positive COVID case(via District 1 Reporting Protocol):
    - Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing -or-
    - Loss of taste or smell -or-
    - New or worsening cough

- If your child is sent home for exhibiting any of these symptoms or has been exposed to a positive COVID case the school nurse will be notified and will contact you regarding Reporting Protocol for the District
