Dear Fall Student Athlete Parents/Guardians:

Welcome to the start of the 2020/2021 school year and fall interscholastic sports season. It is an exciting time for our student athletes, coaches, and community, as we begin the start of competitions in each of our sports. This fall sports season is much different than previous seasons and the expectations for spectators have also changed to follow the guidance of the Michigan High School Athletic Association (MHSAA) and the Kensington Lakes Activities Association (KLAA), in adopting our spectator policy for all indoor and outdoor athletic events. The spectator policy will be followed at all home and away contests.

Please read through the KLAA Spectator Policy and help us ensure a safe environment for all guests and a successful fall sports season for our student athletes.

#### **KLAA Spectator Policy under Executive Order 176**

1. Each Participant (Athlete) will be allowed two spectators at each indoor and outdoor event, as the venue capacity permits.
2. Spectators must be 18 years of age or older or accompanied by an adult, and will count as one of the two spectators per participant (Athlete).
3. Spectators must show ID and identify the participant (Athlete) they represent, to enter the venue. Rosters will be provided to each host school.
4. Face masks must be worn and social distancing must be followed, per executive order.
5. In the occurrence that more than one event is taking place, admission is for only the contest in which the participant (Athlete) is participating. A venue may be cleared of all spectators, prior to allowing spectators to enter the next contest.
6. No re-entry once you exit the venue.
7. Student sections will not be permitted.
8. Concessions will not be available during all indoor and outdoor events.
9. Due to the MHSAA order, Pom, Dance, Marching Band, and other related groups, will not be allowed to participate at or attend football games. Sideline Cheer is permitted (as this group is governed/insured by the MHSAA) as an event participant and will be permitted two guests/athlete.
10. Due to the size of the venue and each team competing, spectator size for swimming & diving will be determined by the host school. The number of spectators may be limited or away team spectators may not be permitted.
11. All MHSAA and State executive orders and protocols will be followed including face coverings and social distancing with people not from the same household.

Additionally, gates/doors will be closed at halftime of each event and additional spectators will not be permitted to enter the venue, once the gates have been closed. Arrive before this time to ensure that you are able to attend.

Please be courteous and cooperative with all game workers/staff, as they are required to follow the above spectator policy. Our top priority is the health/safety of all guests, game workers, and participants, so please do your part to help support interscholastic sports taking place this fall.
