

Physical, history page, and confirmation page(s) turn in instructions

Ayala's athletic trainer, Kayla Wille, will be collecting medical paperwork on Tuesday October 13th and Tuesday October 20th from 2pm – 3pm, via drive thru drop off only. **These dates and times are subject to change, please check back on AyalaSports.com for updates** Everyone must remain in their vehicles in order to comply with social distancing orders. There are three documents that are needed in order for the athlete to be cleared. All physicals must be signed and stamped by an MD or DO, we cannot accept the physical otherwise. Please make sure the history page is completely filled out and signed by both parent and student-athlete, as we will not be able to collect it if not. If confirmation page(s) are not signed or not turned in, in conjunction with the physical and history page, the athlete will not be cleared until that is completed. To receive confirmation pages, log into the student-athlete's account on athleticclearance.com. From there the confirmation page(s) can be printed if you did not receive the email version. Confirmation pages are not generated unless all the information is entered and the account is complete. A student-athlete only needs one physical and one history page for the 2020-2021 academic school year, but will require a sport specific confirmation page for EACH sport they are planning to participate in. Dropping off paperwork will be done by drive-thru method **in front of the tennis courts** at Ayala High School.
