RULES

The Fine Arts/Athletics Complex (FAAC) reserves the right to remove any object from spectators if deemed inappropriate or unsafe.

The following actions and items are prohibited inside the FAAC campus and parking areas and may be cause for removal with no refunds:

- Any item that causes disruption or blocks the view of spectators
- Smoking (includes electronic/vapor cigarettes)
- Throwing or kicking objects or balls of any type
- Disorderly conduct (abusive language toward coaches, student-athletes, officials or spectators; fighting; public intoxication; standing or sitting in the aisles, ramps or walkways)
- Outside food or drinks
- Pets
- Bicycles, skates or skateboards
- Personal heaters
- Laser pointers
- Sticks, poles or similar objects that can be used as a weapon
- Weapons of any kind including those carried with permit
- Fireworks
- Students tailgating without parental supervision
- One vehicle to one parking space. Parents, please tailgate behind your vehicle and keep tailgating items adjacent to front or rear of your vehicle
- Tailgating or gathering is not permitted in the fire lanes or in the roadway
- Violations will be cited by the North Richland Hills Police Department. TABC rules govern all alcohol usage
- Once you exit this facility you will be required to purchase a new ticket to re-enter. No exceptions
- Please place all trash into trash receptacles and help keep our stadium clean
