Where can I find out what sports are offered at Heathwood and what the athletic policies are? ***On the website under MORE you will click on Athletic Handbook***

When can I register my child for a sports season? ***You may register your child for sports when the registration opens for each season. Registration dates open for the different seasons as follows:***

Fall Season - April 30th

Winter Season – September 1st

Spring Season – November 1st

How do I sign my child up for sports at Heathwood? ***You need to register your child on family Id. The link is <https://www.familyid.com/organizations/heathwood-hall-episcopal-school>***

How do I know that my child is cleared to begin practice after registering on Family ID? ***Once you have created and account and registered for a sport on Family ID you will receive an email that you have completed the registration. The Athletic Training office will also receive an email that you have completed your registration and will then view your account to see if all of the documents have been uploaded and are current. If all of the documents have been uploaded, viewed and are current then you will receive an approval for participation. Please note that this process may take 24-48 hours from your completion of the registration process. The coaches will receive a report from Family ID with the approval for participation, if your child has completed the registration process but have not been approved they must wait to participate until approval has been posted.***

What should I do if my child is injured playing a sport or has an illness at? ***The student athlete should let their coach and the athletic trainer knows that they have sustained an injury or have been sick. The coach or athletic trainer will then contact the parent.***

When can the student athlete participate in practices/games after sustaining an injury or being ill? ***If the student athlete has to see a doctor due to injury or illness then the athlete must have a written release from the doctor stating when they can return to play.***
