

Lawrence Free State Spectator Guidelines | Fall, 2020

To ensure the safety of all attendees, the Lawrence Free State Athletic Department, following the Douglas County Health Department's COVID-19 Protocol, asks that you please abide by the guidelines below if/when attending a home event this Fall.

- Do not attend an event if you have any symptoms of COVID-19.
- Do not attend an event if you have been in close proximity to someone who has COVID-19.
- Do not attend an event if you or a family member are considered "high-risk."
- Temperature Checks
 - For outdoor events, conduct a personal temperature check prior to arriving to the event.
 - If you have a temperature of 100.0* or higher, do not attend the event.
 - For indoor activities, facial scan temperature checks for student-athletes, coaches, officials, and spectators will be required for entrance.
 - Anyone with a temperature of 100.0* or higher will be asked to leave campus immediately.
- Masks are required to be worn at all times while on the Free State campus by student-athletes, coaches, officials, and spectators.
- 10' distancing is required for members outside of spectators' immediate family.
- Bring only essential items to an event, and use hand sanitizer frequently.
- The only personnel who will be allowed on the field or courtside are those who have clearance from the Firebirds Athletic Department.
- At the conclusion of the event, exit the facility immediately and refrain from large-group interaction.

Home Events

- Gates will open for spectators 30-45 minutes prior to the start of the event.
- In order to attend a Football, Soccer, and/or Volleyball event, each student-athlete and coach will be required to provide the names of two spectators (*please note these should be family members*) to be recorded on a pass gate list. If you are not listed on the pass gate, you will not be allowed to attend.
 - Upon arrival to the gate, spectators will check-in by providing the name of the person they are there to support and pay admission of \$7 for Adults, \$5 for K-12.*
 - *Until further notice, student sections are not permissible.
 - No walk-up tickets will be sold.
- At this time, we are not requiring a pass gate for Cross Country, Girls Golf, Girls Tennis events.
- Per the Douglas County Health Department, concession stands are closed until further notice.
- Tailgating and/or gathering in the parking lot is not permissible.

Away Events

- It is the expectation that all Free State Firebird student-athletes, coaches, and spectators abide by the Spectator Guidelines as published by the opposing team at minimum. The Free State Athletic Department, however, reserves the right to enact stricter guidelines than the opposing team.
