
INTRODUCTION AND COMMUNITY SAFETY

In order to mitigate risk factors associated with COVID-19 and protect the health of our students, staff and community, the following spectator safety protocols will be in place during the fall sports season. To attend an event, students, staff and fans will:

- Be symptom free of COVID-19.
- Outdoor Activities - Conduct a personal temperature check prior to arriving at the event (temp must be below 100 degrees)
- All indoor Activities - will require a temp check by staff before spectators or participants enter. (temp must be below 100 degrees)
- Arrive with hands sanitized
- Wear a mask upon arrival, throughout the event, and when leaving
- Social distance by 6' (families may sit closer together)
- Bring only essential items to the event
- Not be allowed to interact with teams or be on fields/courts
- Exit facility immediately following the event
- Follow additional mitigation protocols that are sport/activity specific
- Understand that guidelines are subject to change based upon local/state recommendations

HOME TICKETS/ATTENDANCE AT EVENTS (Fall Sports)

- GEHS - Each player receives two (2) tickets per event as listed on roster for all football and soccer players. Volleyball V/JV will receive four (4) tickets per player and Soph/9th will receive (4) tickets per player. There is no cost for these tickets. Tickets are for family members only. Siblings four (4) and under may attend without a ticket and must sit with family (only at home). Students must sit with their family as there will be no student section. Tickets will be provided in a digital format that can only be used once for the event.
- GEHS - Cheer and dance team members receive two (2) tickets per event as listed on the roster in which they are participating. Tickets are for family members only. Tickets will be provided in a digital format that can only be used once for the event. Students must sit with their family as there will be no student section.
- GEHS - Band members receive two (2) tickets per event in which they are participating.
- Tickets are not required for golf, tennis, cross country.
- Special passes (Staff ID's, Senior Citizen, SFL, & Activity) will not be accepted until restrictions are lifted.
- Visiting team spectators - Ticket access will be provided via a link the Sunday prior to the week of events. Visiting AD's are responsible for notifying their families about the number of tickets available for visiting players and families for events hosted by GEHS. Due to the size of our venues and COVID-19 mitigation practices, visitors will receive the following number of tickets: Football 120, Boys Soccer 56, Volleyball V/JV 82, and Volleyball Soph/Fresh 74.

- No home or visitor student group sections allowed during COVID
- USD 231 will make efforts to livestream varsity football, volleyball, and soccer and others if possible.
- Concession stands will not be available.
- USD 231 reserves the right to not issue a ticket to anyone not willing to follow these guidelines. Staff members have the authority to enforce mitigation protocols.

Fall 2020 Blazer Athletics Digital Ticketing Information: Visiting Fans

Gardner Edgerton High School will be utilizing digital ticketing for the Fall 2020 athletics seasons. There is no cost for these tickets. Tickets are for family members only. Siblings four (4) and under may attend without a ticket and must sit with family. Students must sit with their family as there will be no student section. Please see the list below for instructions on how to claim and access your digital tickets.

- Go to www.trailblazerathletics.org
- Click on "Tickets" in the top right corner
- Click "Buy Tickets"
- Either sign-in to your VNN account or sign-up for the first time (no cost, just requires basic information.)
- Click "Have a Passcode"
 - ***The visiting school's AD will receive the pass code for each event and will communicate this with their families.***
- They will have the option of claiming up to 4 free tickets for each volleyball contest, and up to 2 free tickets for each football and soccer game. Due to the various sizes of our venues, the amount of total visiting tickets allowed to be claimed are capped as follows:
 - *Football = 120, Boys Soccer = 56, V/JV Volleyball = 82, 9/10 Volleyball = 74*
- When they get to GEHS, they can either show the ticket barcode on their device or print it out
 - Each ticket can only be scanned and used one time
