Lawrence Free State Spectator Guidelines | Fall, 2020

To ensure the safety of all attendees, the Lawrence Free State Athletic Department, following the Douglas County Health Department's COVID-19 Protocol, asks that you please abide by the guidelines below if/when attending a home event this Fall.

- Do not attend an event if you have any symptoms of COVID-19.
- Do not attend an event if you have been in close proximity to someone who has COVID-19.
- Do not attend an event if you or a family member are considered "high-risk."
- Temperature Checks
 - o For outdoor events, conduct a personal temperature check prior to arriving to the event.
 - If you have a temperature of 100.0* or higher, do not attend the event.
 - o For indoor activities, facial scan temperature checks for student-athletes, coaches, officials, and spectators will be required for entrance.
 - Anyone with a temperature of 100.0* or higher will be asked to leave campus immediately.
- Masks are required to be worn at all times while on the Free State campus by student-athletes, coaches, officials, and spectators.
- 10' distancing is required for members outside of spectators' immediate family.
- Bring only essential items to an event, and use hand sanitizer frequently.
- The only personnel who will be allowed on the field or courtside are those who have clearance from the Firebirds Athletic Department.
- At the conclusion of the event, exit the facility immediately and refrain from large-group interaction.

Home Events

- Gates will open for spectators 30-45 minutes prior to the start of the event.
- In order to attend a Football, Soccer, and/or Volleyball event, each student-athlete and coach will be allowed to invite two spectators to attend the event (*please note these should be family members*). Please see page two of this document for instructions on how to purchase tickets.
 - o Until further notice, student sections are not permissible.
 - o No walk-up tickets will be sold.
- At this time, we are not requiring tickets for Cross Country, Girls Golf, Girls Tennis events.
- Per the Douglas County Health Department, concession stands are closed until further notice.
- Tailgating and/or gathering in the parking lot is not permissible.

Away Events

- It is the expectation that all Free State Firebird student-athletes, coaches, and spectators abide by the Spectator Guidelines as published by the opposing team at minimum. The Free State Athletic Department, however, reserves the right to enact stricter guidelines than the opposing team.

Lawrence Free State Firebirds HomeTown Ticketing

In an effort to create a cashless payment system that helps mitigate the risk of exposure to COVID-19 and a more efficient entry process at home athletic events, Lawrence Free State will transition to digital ticketing for all JV and Varsity athletic contests effective Monday, September 28, 2020. Please note if there is a Varsity event scheduled for the same night as a sub-varsity game, the sub-varsity spectators will also need to purchase a ticket.

Spectator Guidelines

- Each student-athlete/coach is allowed two spectators (tickets) to attend a home event.
 - o Tickets must be purchased for family members only.
- Siblings under the age of five may attend without a ticket and must sit with family.
- K-12 students must sit with family student sections are prohibited.
- Ticket Prices
 - Adult \$8.55 (\$7 Sunflower League Pricing + \$1.55 Processing Fee)
 - O K-12 Student \$6.45 (\$5 Sunflower League Pricing + \$1.45 Processing Fee)
- The COVID-specific guidelines for spectators are in effect until further notice.

How to Purchase Tickets

- O1.Go to www.freestateathletics.com.
- O2.Click on "Tickets" in the upper righthand corner.
- 03. Click "Buy Tickets."
- 04. Sign-in to your VNN account (or sign-up at no cost if you are a first-time user).
- 05. Click "Have Passcode."
 - a. Free State student-athletes/coaches will be provided with a personal passcode.
 - b. The visiting team's AD will receive a passcode for the event and will communicate this to the coaching staff/families.
- 06. Each passcode will allow the purchase of a total of two tickets. Once the two tickets have been purchased, the passcode is void for that event.
- 07. Once the transaction is complete, the purchaser will receive an email containing the ticket(s).
- 08. Upon arrival to Free State, spectators may show their ticket(s) on a phone or a printed ticket.
 - a. Each ticket can only be used one time screenshotting/sharing pictures will void the ticket.
