

## **Scott Glabb**

***Head Coach – Wrestling***

***1990-2018***

***In the fall of 1990, Scott took his teaching and coaching skills to Santa Ana High School at a time when the sport was struggling dismally to gain the respect of the Orange County Wrestling community. However, while studying at California State University, Long Beach to earn a second degree in English Literature and a California Teaching Credential, he guided the Saints to their first league Championship in 1993 - a Santa Ana High historical feat. Today the program has won twenty-six consecutive league titles. By 1996, Glabb's team had won the CIF DIV. III team championships and went on to capture the 1998, 1999, 2001 and 2003 CIF Team and Dual Meet Titles. In 2007, 2008 & 2010 The Saints won 3 more CIF Dual Meet Championships. In 2016, The Saints won the Southern Div. CIF Championships, leading to a total of 13 CIF titles for the wrestling program as well as CIF runner-up 11 times.***

***With girls wrestling as one of the fastest growing sports in California, CIF created a regional and state championship series for the girl's. Since 2009 Santa Ana girl's wrestling team has had parallel success of that of the boys team with a 4th place finish in state in 2012, a 2nd place finish at State in 2013, and a 6th place finish in 2014. The girls program has 2 State champions, 11 State place winners, 5 CIF Champions, and 4 All-Americans.***

***The highlight of Glabb's coaching tenure was when the team won the Southern Section Master's Meet in 1999 and placed 4th in the California State Championships. To date, he has compiled an overall record of 414 wins and 71 losses – a win percentage of 85%. He has coached 36 individual CIF champions, 66 State qualifiers and 18 State place winners, 1 State champion, and 2 National champions.***

***Glabb is currently a member of the Orange County Wrestling Coaches Association and a member of the CIF Wrestling Advisory Committee. He won the Orange County Register's Wrestling "Coach of the Year" Award in 1996 and 1998, the LA Times "Coach of the Year" in 1996, and the National Wrestling***

***Coaches Association "California State Wrestling Coach of the Year" in 1999. He was also the recipient of the California Coaches Association State Wrestling Coach of the Year award in 2007. Glabb was inducted into the National Wrestling Hall of Fame: California Chapter in 2014 and was also inducted into the California Wrestling Hall of Fame in 2015.***

***Glabb is involved with the Campus Ministry "Fellowship of Christian Athletes" and was honored as the FCA "John Wooden" Southern California Coach of the Year in 2003. In May 2004 Glabb was presented the "Coaches & Spouse Influence Award" by the Coaches of Influence Christian Ministry and was presented the Community Recognition Award by the city of Santa Ana Parks and Recreation Board.***

***In 2010 Glabb published a book called "A Saint in the City." It is the story of the individual journeys of a young coach who had been battling depression ... and his wrestlers who overcame various challenges of their own to find redemption in wrestling, and for their lives beyond the mat.***
