Dave is recognized by the high school cross country and track & field community as the premier announcer in the CIF Southern Section. Beginning in 1976 Dave could be heard announcing every major high school track & field invitational including the Mt. SAC Invitational as well as the nationally known Arcadia Invitational, the CIF-SS Prelims, CIF-SS Finals, CIF Masters Meet, and the CIF State Meet Finals. His spring weekends are filled announcing the Earl Engman Relays, the Irvine Invitational, the Laguna Beach Invitational, the San Clemente Invitational, the Trabuco Hills Invitational, and the Orange County Championships.

In 2008, after 30+ years of outstanding service to the sports of cross country and track & field, David was honored as a Distinguished Service Award Recipient by the CIF Southern Section. While he has retired from his career as a teacher and coach at Loara High School, he continues to serve as the voice of track and cross country throughout the Southern Section to this day.
