



# Arcanum Athletic Department

Dear Trojan Fans,

While the season may not look like what we are used to, the Arcanum-Butler Administration and Athletic Department are excited that our student athletes will have an opportunity to play the sport that they love and have worked hard to prepare for!

The Director's Order released on August 19 provides mandatory requirements for schools to follow in order for competition to proceed. In doing so, the expectations are that schools, student athletes, and fans are compliant with the order and are subject to penalties by either the Department of Health and/or OHSAA. Because we want our student athletes to have a season, we must all join together and do what is required to make this happen.

As parents, families and fans, you can help us by following the guidance. The following points are specific to our fans and operations associated with contests.

## **NEW TICKET POLICY FOR 2020 SEASON**

- *Passes will NOT be accepted for any event.*
- *No general admission, vouchers will be used for home events/presale possible for away events.*
- *Protocols will be in place to allow for contact-free ticketing (gloves worn by ticket takers etc.)*

## **FOOTBALL (HS/JV/MS), BAND, CHEERLEADING - Home Contests**

- Each player/family will receive 4 vouchers. Spectators will present their voucher along with payment to purchase a ticket at the gate.
- Pods will be available in lawn seating (4 chairs/pod)
- Visiting teams - 100 vouchers
  - HS Varsity events \$6
  - Non-Varsity events \$4

## **FOOTBALL (HS/JV/MS), BAND, CHEERLEADING - Away Contests**

- Host school will determine the number of tickets based on their capacity.
- The number of tickets available will be communicated when we receive that information.
- Voucher or presale only ticket distribution may be possible.
- Band will not travel.

## **VOLLEYBALL (HS/MS) - Home Contests**

- Each player/family will receive 5 vouchers. Spectators will present their voucher along with payment to purchase a ticket at the gate.
- Visiting teams - 80 vouchers
  - HS Varsity events \$6
  - Non-Varsity events \$4
- ALL MS Volleyball games will be played in the HS gym to allow for more capacity.

## **VOLLEYBALL (HS/MS) - Away Contests**

- Host school will determine the number of tickets based on their capacity.
- The number of tickets will be communicated when we receive that information.
- Voucher or presale only ticket distribution may be possible.

## **SPECTATOR GUIDELINES FOR 2020 SEASON**

### **Social Distancing**

- Maintain a six-foot distance from other individuals while entering and exiting our facilities, while at line for concessions, and throughout the contest.
- No congregating before, during and after all competitions. While it is customary for parents to wait for student-athletes after the game on the field/court, parents must exit the facility immediately following the contest.
- Spacing markers will be used for student athletes and fans at various locations throughout the gyms and/or fields
- Limits will be posted at all restroom facilities.
- One-way entries, exits and aisles will be utilized.

### **Enforcement**

- School district's are required to assign a compliance officer to oversee operations and be the main point of contact for local emergency and health agencies. Superintendent, John Stephens, will serve in this capacity for the district while Athletic Director, Abbey Moore, will assist as needed.
- Venues must follow all requirements in the Order.
- The school and/or team/program are subject to penalties for not following and enforcing the Order.

### **Spectator Guidelines**

- Spectators must conduct daily symptom assessments at home prior to the contest.
- Anyone experiencing COVID-19 symptoms must stay at home.
- Family and household members should sit together socially-distanced from other individuals/family/household members.
- Spectators must wear face coverings at all times except for one of the reasons stated in the Director's Order for Facial Coverings throughout the State of Ohio, signed July 23, 2020, or as it may thereafter be amended.

### **Capacity and Seating**

- Spectators will present their voucher at the gate along with payment to receive a ticket.
- Admission Prices:
  - HS Varsity Events \$6
  - Non-Varsity Events \$4
- Family only is recommended with each group seated together.
- Spectators must sit in the assigned seats/spaces (marked with tape), distanced by 6 feet, and in staggered rows/sections to prevent contact between groups.

### **Concessions and Restrooms**

- Follow Responsible RestartOhio Guidance for Bars & Restaurants.
- Maintain social distancing while in line and as indicated by markings.
- Cleaning and sanitizing of restrooms will occur throughout the contest.
