Dear Trojan Fans,

While the season may not look like what we are used to, the Arcanum-Butler Administration and Athletic Department are excited that our student athletes will have an opportunity to play the sport that they love and have worked hard to prepare for!

The Director's Order released on August 19 provides mandatory requirements for schools to follow in order for competition to proceed. In doing so, the expectations are that schools, student athletes, and fans are compliant with the order and are subject to penalties by either the Department of Health and/or OHSA. Because we want our student athletes to have a season, we must all join together and do what is required to make this happen.

As parents, families and fans, you can help us by following the guidance. The following points are specific to our fans and operations associated with contests.

NEW TICKET POLICY FOR 2020-2021 WINTER ATHLETIC SEASON

- *No general admission, vouchers/team passes will be used for home events.*
- *Protocols will be in place to allow for contact-free ticketing (gloves worn by ticket takers etc.)*

BOYS BASKETBALL (Varsity/JV/Freshman/Junior High) - Home Contests

Home spectators: each athlete will have an opportunity to purchase **FOUR** Arcanum team passes

Visiting spectators: will receive vouchers that must be presented at the gate with payment for admission

- Visiting Teams: **80 vouchers**
 - High School events \$6
 - Junior High events \$4
 - Gym will NOT be cleared between Freshman/JV/Varsity or 7th/8th grade contests

GIRLS BASKETBALL (Varsity/JV/Junior High) - Home Contests

Home spectators: each athlete will have an opportunity to purchase **SIX** Arcanum team passes

Visiting spectators: will receive vouchers that must be presented at the gate with payment for admission

- Visiting Teams: **80 vouchers**
 - High School events \$6
 - Junior High events \$4
 - Gym will NOT be cleared between JV/Varsity or 7th/8th grade contests

HS and JH BOYS & GIRLS BASKETBALL (Varsity/JV/Freshman) - Away Contests

- Host schools will determine the number of tickets based on their capacity.
- The number of tickets available will be communicated when we receive that information.
- Voucher or presale only ticket distribution may be possible.
- Cheerleaders will not travel.

Winter Athletic Team Passes - Available for athletes families for their respective team

- HSBB Pass, HSGB Pass, JHBB Pass, JHGB Pass
- Athletes can purchase these from Mrs. Moore in the Athletic office starting 11/23

Pricing: HS Boys and Girls Passes = \$50 / JH Boys and Girls Passes = \$25

- Each home spectator must have a pass or voucher
- Each pass will only provide admittance to that athlete's perspective sport
- Families who do not purchase passes will receive vouchers for each game

**Home wrestling spectators will receive vouchers for home matches.*

SPECTATOR GUIDELINES FOR 2020 SEASON

Social Distancing

- Maintain a six-foot distance from other individuals while entering and exiting our facilities, while at line for concessions, and throughout the contest.
- No congregating before, during and after all competitions. While it is customary for parents to wait for student-athletes after the game in the gym, parents must exit the facility immediately following the contest.
- Bleachers will be marked with tape to allow for social distancing.
- Limits will be posted at all restroom facilities.
- One-way entries, exits and aisles will be utilized.

Enforcement

- School district's are required to assign a compliance officer to oversee operations and be the main point of contact for local emergency and health agencies. Superintendent, John Stephens, will serve in this capacity for the district while Athletic Director, Abbey Moore, will assist as needed.
- Venues must follow all requirements in the Order.
- The school and/or team/program are subject to penalties for not following and enforcing the Order.

Spectator Guidelines

- Spectators must conduct daily symptom assessments at home prior to the contest.
- Anyone experiencing COVID-19 symptoms must stay at home.
- Family and household members should sit together socially-distanced from other individuals/family/household members.
- Spectators must wear face coverings at all times except for one of the reasons stated in the Director's Order for Facial Coverings throughout the State of Ohio, signed July 23, 2020, or as it may thereafter be amended.

Capacity and Seating

- Home spectators will present their team pass at the gate for admission
- Away spectators will present their voucher at the gate along with payment to receive a ticket.
- Admission Prices:
 - HS Events \$6
 - JH Events \$4
- Family only is recommended with each group seated together.
- Spectators must sit in the assigned seats/spaces (marked with tape), distanced by 6 feet, and in staggered rows/sections to prevent contact between groups.

Concessions

- Follow Responsible RestartOhio Guidance for Bars & Restaurants.
- Maintain social distancing while in line and as indicated by markings.
- Concession will be limited to pop and candy only. Please plan accordingly.
