Ticket Information

- OHSAA playoff tickets are \$12.00 each.
- Tickets will be for sale online from **Wednesday 12:00 pm/noon to Friday 12:00 pm/noon.**
- Each football, band, cheer, and dance line family will receive their code(s) for the game from Mr. Sammartino. You can contact him by phone, email, or in person to retrieve your codes.
- Each code is equal to (2) tickets. Ticket codes will no longer expire on Friday at noon.
- There will no longer be ticket sales to the general admission per the Governor's orders/OHSAA as of Wednesday, October 7, 2020 10:00 pm.
- Per the OHSAA, regardless of age (0-100) every individual must have a purchased ticket to enter the game.

To purchase tickets:

1. Inform parents they need to visit www.ohsaa.org/tickets
2. Once on that page, they will select the sport and go to the event location that your school is participating in
3. Select the blue "have a passcode" button and enter the **provided to you by your athletic director or coach** for tickets to appear
4. Tickets will be sent to the email address they provide during the purchase
5. Tickets can be kept on their phone or printed and brought to the event to be scanned for entry

Ticket Breakdown

- Each varsity football family will receive a total 4 tickets per family (2 Codes).
- Each band, cheer, and dance line family grades 10-12 will receive a total of 4 tickets per family (2 codes).
- Each band, cheer, and dance line family grades 7-9 will receive a total of 2 tickets per family (1 code).

Game Day Information

- All school personnel, coaching staff, media, and workers must have a field pass given to them by the athletic director.
- Gates will open at 6:00 pm. Concession stands will be open behind the visitor side bleachers.
- Restrooms will be available on the home and away side.
- Once you enter the stadium, you cannot exit and reenter.
- Team busses will be parked behind the home side bleachers.
- Those attending the game are required to wear a mask and follow social distancing mandates and rules set forth by the office Governor DeWine and the Mahoning County Health Department.
