Title IX Proportionality Figures for RHS

Providing participation opportunities for male and female RHS student-athletes is one of our top priorities. The percentage of female student-athletes should be proportionate to the overall female population of the school. The ratio needed for compliance is determined on a case-by-case basis by the Office for Civil Rights (OCR). In general, to be considered “proportional” means the ratios must be within five percent (5%) or less. The participation figures at RHS during the 2018-19 school year were as follows:
