Athletic Academic Probation - Upperclassman

Last quarter your grade point average was below a 2.0. The Brunswick City Schools requires all upperclass student athletes (grades 10-12) whose grade point average (GPA) is below a 2.0 to be on academic probation (class determination is determined by student's expected graduation year). The following is the explanation of the probationary period:

- 1. The probationary period will last four weeks.
- 2. During those four weeks you can participate, but are subject to certain requirements:
 - a. A weekly progress sheet signed by each of your teachers will be turned in to the Athletic Office every Friday beginning the second week of the quarter.
 - b. Your parents must sign the the progress report each week indicating you are studying at home.
 - c. Your head coach must sign the progress report each week.

If after the fourth week (interim grade), your grades are at/above a 2.0 GPA, you will be removed from academic probation. If your GPA is below a 2.0, your participation in the sport/activity is over for the remainder of the grading period. There is no reimbursement for any pay to participate fee that was paid for the sport/activity.

It is the responsibility of the student to hand in a weekly progress report completed, as well as signed by both parent and head coach on Friday during the probationary period.

By signing below, you understand the conditions to participate in a sport/activity while on academic probation. Failure to sign will lead to the student denial of participation.
