

2020 Clinton Central Swimming and Diving Family Admissions Policy

This communication is being sent to notify all parents of Clinton Central High School's spectator policies for our home Swimming and Diving meets in conjunction with the Clinton County Health Department. Each home meet will be livestreamed (internet video) on Clinton Central's Facebook page via the Facebook Live feature.

Due to local guidelines for crowd capacity limits, Clinton Central's pool bleacher seating will be capped at 50 spectators for dual (two boys/girls team) meets. Visiting team spectators will not be offered seats.

The 2020-21 season holds 8 total home events. Each player family will be guaranteed to attend 4 of these 8 events, either as a spectator or as an event worker. In the event, additional opportunities to attend become available, we will notify all parents.

Dual meets (CC and one visiting school) 12/3, 1/5, and 1/19

In order to allow all parents the opportunity to watch their student athlete, we are limiting each player's family to attend 2 of these 3 events or attend 1 event and work 1 event of the three. **This will count as 2 of your 4 attendances.**

For these dual home meets **two** spectator tickets per athlete will be available for purchase online. A link will be sent to families the week of the event to purchase online tickets. Tickets will NOT be available for purchase at the door. ***If a family has purchased an All-Sport pass, it will be honored but ONLY two admissions will be allowed in place of ordering tickets online.***

Please note: If a parent worker(s) are event workers (timer, scorer, etc.) additional admissions (more than two) are NOT allowed. Face coverings are required to be worn at all times through-out the meet.

Multiple team events 12/5, 12/12, 12/17, 1/7, 1/23

For home meets with multiple teams (3 teams or more), 0 spectators will be offered seats. To be fair and allow all family's equal time to work these home meets, each player family will be allowed to work 2 of these 5 events. **Only two assigned event workers (personnel working the event in an official capacity) per athlete** will be allowed into the facility. **This will count as 2 of your 4 attendances.**

Our swimming and diving coaches will communicate with your family on the meets you will be assigned to work. Face coverings are required to be worn all times through-out the meet.

We understand how restrictive the above policy is, but please understand these safeguards will enable our student-athletes to have a season and compete, which ultimately is the goal for the 2020 Winter Sports season.
