## **Cheer Division**

Routines will be no longer than 3 minutes. Routines are required to have at least one cheer/chant and at least one music section. Music section must be between 45 seconds and 1 minute and 30 seconds. Judging will start with the first organized word or first beat of music. Mounting teams will only be allowed in the mounting divisions.

## **Dance Division**

Routines will be no longer than 3 minutes. Routines must be approved for all ages. Dance divisions will also be competing on cheer floor.

- Spectator's admission \$6 per person. Ages 6 and under are free.
- There will be concessions and t-shirts for sale.
- Each Team/Individual will receive their score sheets and a composite score sheet of your division after the awards ceremony.
- There will be a jump off and/or tuck off. \$5 per participant
