## **Objective:**

The objective of the Dayton Christian Athletic Booster Club Scholarship Program is to:

- Reward outstanding graduating high school seniors for their athletic, academic, spiritual, and leadership achievements;
- Provide financial assistance in order that they may accomplish their future educational goals; and
- Assist in developing future leaders.

## **Application Requirements:**

In order to qualify for consideration the applicant must meet the following criteria:

- Be a graduating DC high school senior;
- Have earned or be in the process of earning a varsity letter for any sport at DC;
- Submit a copy of their college acceptance letter, if available;
- Submit a list of sports-related leadership activities outside DC;
- Submit a 250 word essay on how participating in DC sports has affected their spiritual walk.

## **Award Selection Procedure:**

All student-athletes meeting the application requirements will be evaluated and scored based on the athletic, academic, spiritual, and leadership achievements provided in the application submission. A selection panel composed of unbiased individuals will review all applications received, score each applicant, and make final recommendations to the Athletic Booster Club, who will then approve the final award winners.

## **Recognition:**

The Dayton Christian Athletic Booster Club will award **four (4) \$1,000 scholarships**. Scholarships will be presented to the students by the president of the Athletic Boosters. Notification of future academic plans will be required before disbursement of the scholarship checks to the recipients.

Definition/Descriptions of Scholarship Application Categories and Scoring

**Athletic Achievement (18 points):** Points for athletic achievement are based on both team and individual awards that the applicant received while participating in varsity sports at DCS. All varsity sport recognition received for grades 9-12 varsity sport participation is eligible.

- OHSAA State Award winner/team recognition= 3 points
- OHSAA District award winner/team recognition = 2 points
- OHSAA League Awards winner/ team recognition =1 point
- Individual State award recognition= 1 point per award/recognition (2points max)
- Individual District Award recognition=1 point per award/recognition (2 points max)
- Individual League Award recognition =1 point per award/recognition (2points max)
- Team Captain=1 point per Team Captainty (2 points max)
- Varsity Letter = 1 point per (2 points max)
- Awards given by Varsity Coach =1 point per (2 points max)

**Academic Achievement: (5 points)** Academic achievement points will be based on Grade Point Average from your honors weighted GPA.

- GPA 4.0-3.5 = 4 points
- 3.4-3.0 = 3 points
- 2.9-2.5= 2points
- 2.4-2.0 = 1 points

Class Rank= Top 25%= 1 point

**Leadership Ability- (10 points):** 250-word essay on how you have been a leader and provide service to the community in sports outside of the school that is related to a sport. This would include, but is not limited to, helping to coach a team of younger children, teaching a sports camp, and or doing any type of missions work related to sports, etc.

**Spiritual Impact (10 points):** A 250 word essay explaining how playing on a Dayton Christian team has strengthened their Christian walk.

Essay Rubric:

- Length (2 points)
- Grammar, spelling, writing style (2 points)
- Leadership/ Spiritual relevance (6 points)
