## **2018-2019 Athletic Pass Information**

We are currently in the process of implementing a new season pass system. This new process will give you the option of having digital tickets on your smartphone or printing your tickets from home. You will be able to buy the same season passes at the same price as before along with purchasing single game tickets through this same service. This will not only make things more convenient for the fans, but also make it easier on our game staff to monitor our season pass list to get you in the gates more efficiently. Please be patient. To register online use the following instructions:

1. Go to [marengo.8to18.com](http://marengo.8to18.com)
2. Click "Create an Account" (if you have not registered before) and enter your own email and create your own password. **(Please be sure to remember this password as you will use this for the years to come for all of your children.)**
3. Click on "Begin Registration"
4. "Select Activity"
  - a. Choose the sport your child will be trying out for/participating in.
5. "Select Participant"
  - a. Add a New Participant (or choose your child once created)
  - b. \*\*\*\*\*Please note: All information on this page is for the student, i.e. cell phone, email, etc.
6. "Roster Details"
  - a. You may be asked for t-shirt size
  - b. Height and Weight will be used for rosters
7. "Primary Parent/Guardian Information"
  - a. Fill out the parent information on the next page
8. "Physical Form"
  - a. If you need a form to take to the doctor, you may print it here. This will be the ONLY form that you will be turning into the school.
  - b. **REMEMBER: Your athlete must have a current physical in order to begin tryouts/practice.**
9. "Legal Form"
  - a. At this time, by clicking on the boxes, you are agreeing and consenting to all information provided.
  - b. You may click on the form to read or print. Please note that when there is a parent/guardian and student check box- they must both be checked to move forward.
  - c. Please do not turn in any forms filled out
10. "Summary"
  - a. At this time, you can see what you have registered for
  - b. Click on "Finish" to complete your registration.
