-- More playing tennis, including team tennis on Thursdays

-- Meets Mon-Thur

-- Cost: 1 Session \$130, Both Sessions \$200

EVENING CLASSES

-- one time in the evening, there will NOT always be high school coaches there, but one of our teaching pros will be.

-- Meets from 6:30 to 7:30

-- If your child wants to do “team tennis” on Thursdays, you can bring them on Thursdays at 8:30 am, NO EXTRA CHARGE.

-- ONLY MEETS MON-WED (Thursdays optional 8:30am)

--Cost 1 Session \$90, Both Sessions \$140
