For Athletic Fields and Gyms

For general safety, all people coming onto the campus will need to have their temperature taken by a coach, AD, trainer, or nurse, before being able to participate. Coaches will have their temperatures taken as well.

- If someone is showing a fever of 100.4 (CDC recommended) or over, they will be asked to go home.
- No more than 10 participants at a time if we are in Phase 1 of Arizona's re-opening. No more than 25 participants indoors, 50 participants outdoors at a time if we are in Phase 2, and an unlimited amount of participants if we are in Phase 3 or are in regular season practice mode.
- At all times, and until further notice, temperatures will be taken before admittance to campus for practices/training.
- A hand-sanitizer station will be in effect prior to and after using the equipment and practicing. All athletes will use hand sanitizer before and after practice/work outs. Handwashing is recommended and encouraged before leaving the practice/training session.

For Weight Rooms

For general safety, all people coming onto the campus will need to have their temperature taken by a coach, AD, trainer, or nurse, before being able to participate. Coaches will have their temperatures taken as well.

- If someone is showing a fever of 100.4 (CDC recommended) or over, they will be asked to go home.
- No more than 6 participants at a time if we are in Phase 1 of Arizona's re-opening. No more than 12 participants (or based on weight room size and occupancy) at a time if we are in Phase 2, and an unlimited number of participants if we are in Phase 3.
- At all times, and until further notice, temperatures will be taken before admittance to campus for practices/training.
- After using the equipment, it will be sanitized and needs to dry (at least 30 seconds) before the next person uses it.
- A hand-sanitizer station will be in effect prior to and after using the equipment and practicing. All athletes will use hand sanitizer before and after practice/work outs. A twenty second thorough handwashing is recommended after the practice or training has ended.

A Few Other Reminders

- No drinking fountains will be accessible during workouts/practices. Players must bring their own water from home.
- Utilize only one restroom, either lobby, coach/single, if needed; it will need to be cleaned after each day.
- Parents will not be allowed to come onto campus, either into the gym or onto the field, but will need to drop off and pick up from their cars only.

- Any equipment used will need to be sanitized once completed for the day. For the weight room, equipment will need to be sanitized after each use.
- After using water bottles, use hand sanitizer again before going back to practice, training.
- After using the restroom, twenty second thorough handwashing/sanitizing before practicing or training resumes.
