*The following protocols are being put in place to help ensure student-athlete and spectator safety at home athletic events in the sport of softball during the 2020-2021 school year. Please note that these protocols may change depending on guidelines issued from the CDC, Georgia Department of Public Health, Georgia High School Association and Fayette County Public Schools.*

### **TICKETING:**

McIntosh High School will use GoFan to provide digital ticketing. Tickets may be purchased online prior to games or at the gate using **card or mobile payments only**.

### **FAN EXPERIENCE:**

- Total capacity will be limited to 100 fans - 50% of maximum allowed to encourage social distancing.
- If available, concessions will be limited to pre-packaged food items only. All concessions workers will wear face coverings and gloves at all times.
- **Face coverings are strongly recommended for all spectators attending outdoor sporting events.**
- Announcements regarding Social Distancing guidelines will be made throughout the contest/event.
- Maintain 6 feet between individuals/family groups; only family members may sit together
- Bleachers will not be available for seating. **Please bring a lawn/camping chair to sit on!**
- Access to athletes will be limited. Please follow all signs and do not enter the extended dugout areas (marked with caution tape).
- Children under 14 must be accompanied and supervised by an adult.
- Restrooms will be sanitized at the conclusion of each game.
- Hand sanitizer will be provided at the game entrance by request.

### **PROTECTING STUDENT-ATHLETES:**

- Each team will provide their own game ball, and will sanitize it per recommended guidelines.
- Team huddles without social distancing are not allowed
- Physical distancing will be practiced in dugouts; dugouts will be extended into out of play areas to encourage distancing.
- Athletes will not share gloves, bats, or helmets.
- Sunflower seeds are prohibited.
- Physical distancing will be practiced at all times, including changes to on deck areas, umpire positioning, etc.
