



Dear John Hay parents & student-athletes,

Below you will find the requirements for athletic eligibility at John Hay High School.

All four of the following criteria must be complete in order to participate in John Hay athletics.

Athlete Eligibility

For athletes to be eligible they must:

- Have an updated physical on file.
- Have all forms completed in Final Forms.
- Complete the IMPACT concussion baseline test.
- Be academically eligible.

IF ONE OR MORE OF THESE IS NOT COMPLETE YOU WILL NOT BE ABLE TO PLAY SPORTS AT JOHN HAY HIGH SCHOOL.

Physicals

Athletic physicals are to be completed yearly by a medical professional and the completed OHSAA physical form must be turned in to your coach or AD Thornburg. The [official 2019-2020 OHSAA physical form](#) MUST be used in order for the physical to be valid. The physical lasts for 12 months and it is required to be on file at John Hay and in Final Forms in order to participate in sports.

You can find the 2019-2020 OHSAA physical form [HERE](#) or you can pick one up from a coach, AD Thornburg, or at John Hay High School.

When you go to complete the physical, the pre-participation sheet should be filled out in its entirety. Once the physical is complete, bring the form to your coach or AD Thornburg.

Final Forms

All forms in Final Forms must be completed and updated yearly in order to be eligible for sports at John Hay. You can find the [sign-up instructions HERE](#) and a [letter from AD Thornburg HERE](#).



IMPACT Test

First, be sure to sign the IMPACT test consent form in your Final Forms account. Then you will complete the IMPACT test with your team at the beginning of the season. If for some reason you are unable to be there when it is administered, contact your coach or AD Thornburg. If you do not complete the IMPACT test, you will not be eligible to participate.

Academic Eligibility

The Cleveland Metropolitan School District prohibits students in grades 7 through 12 from participating in interscholastic extracurricular activities if they fail to meet all of the following eligibility requirements:

1. the student must not receive a failing grade in the previous grading period;
2. the student must have a grade point average of 2.0 or higher in the previous grading period;
3. the student must also have a cumulative grade point average of 2.0 or higher.
